<i>Categories of Newspaper.</i>	<i>Bank balance (in taka).</i>
(a) Dailies published from Dhaka, Chittagong and Khulna. ..	5,00,000. (Five lac).
(b) Dailies published from places other than Dhaka, Chittagong and Khulna. ...	2,00,000 (Two lac).
(c) Weeklies published from Dhaka, Chittagong and Khulna. ..	1,00,000 (One lac).
(d) Weeklies published from places other than Dhaka, Chittagong and Khulna. ..	50,000 (Fifty thousand).
(e) Fortnightlies and Monthlies ...	30,000 (Thirty thousand).

**No. S.R.O. 360-L/84.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 of the Printing Presses and Publications (Declaration and Registration) Act, 1973 (XXIII of 1973), and in supersession of this Ministry's notification No. S.R.O. 187-L/80, dated the 13th June, 1980, the Government is pleased to direct that the printer of every newspaper shall deliver—

- (1) three copies of each issue of such newspaper to the Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs, Political Branch, Bangladesh Secretariat, Dhaka at his office; and
- (2) one copy of each issue of such newspaper to the officers mentioned below at their respective offices:—
  - (a) in the case of a newspaper printed in Dhaka—
    - (i) Director, Department of Films and Publications, 112, Circuit House Road, Dhaka;
    - (ii) Deputy Commissioner, Dhaka; and
    - (iii) Deputy Inspector-General of Police, Special Branch, Dhaka; and
  - (b) in the case of a newspaper printed outside Dhaka—
    - (i) Director, Department of Films and Publications, 112, Circuit House Road, Dhaka;

- (ii) Deputy Commissioner of the district within the local limits of which the newspaper is printed; and
- (iii) Superintendent of Police, Special Branch of the district within the local limits of which the newspaper is printed.
