Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government have decided to prohibit the bringing into Bangladesh by air, sea or land any copy of the aforesaid magazine or any other book, paper or document containing copies, reprints or translations of, or extracts of the said magazine
