No. S.R.O. 368-I/77/4R-1/77/CD(AC)878.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 12 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1958 (XL of 1958), and in supersession of all rules made in this behalf, the Government is pleased to make the following rules, namely:

THE CRIMINAL LAW AMENDMENT (SANCTION FOR PROSECUTION) RULES, 1977.

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Criminal Law Amendment (Sanction for Prosecution) Rules, 1977.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. **Definition.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context, “Act” means the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1958 (XL of 1958).

3. **Sanction for prosecution.**—Sanction for prosecution of public servants as required under sub-section (5) of section 6 of the Act shall be accorded by the Government in the Cabinet Division.

4. **Place and time of sitting of the court.**—(1) Every Special Judge may hold his court at the headquarters of each district within his jurisdiction to try the cases under the Act.

(2) The ordinary hours of sitting for the court of Special Judge shall be according to the hours fixed for the civil courts located in the headquarters of the district.

PROCLAMATION

Whereas it has been made to appear to me that accused (1) Mr Khairul Kabir, son of Mr Mahababur Rahman of section X, Block A, Road No. 6, House No. 37, Mirpur, Dacca, formerly Secretary-cum-Managing Director of Commercial Co-operative Bank Ltd., Dacca, is required for the purpose of trial in the Special Martial Law Court No. I, of Ganabhaban, Dacca under Regulation 3(7) of the Martial Law Regulation No. I of 1975;

And whereas this Court has reason to believe that the said accused (1) Mr Khairul Kabir is absconding or concealing himself to avoid appearance or arrest for the said purpose;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Regulation 3(7) of the Martial Law Regulation No. I, of 1975 this Special Martial Law Court No. I, at Ganabhaban, Dacca., do hereby direct—

That the above accused person to appear in this Court on 23rd January 1978 at 10 a. m. failing which he will be tried *in absentia* in M.L. Case No. 97/77 and his properties may be confiscated to the Government.
