No. S.R.O. 373-L/85/ME(IC)SII-60/84.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE BANGLADESH CIVIL SERVICE (HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING: FAMILY PLANNING) COMPOSITION AND CADRE RULES, 1985.

- Short title.—These rules may be called the Bangladesh Civil Service (Health and Family Planning: Family Planning) Composition and Cadre Rules, 1985.
- 2. Definitions.—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—
 - (a) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
 - (b) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these rules; and
 - (c) "Service" means the Bangladesh Civil Service (Health and Family Planning: Family Planning).

- 3. Constitution of Service.—(1) There shall be constituted a Service to be called the Bangladesh Civil Service (Health and Family Planning).
 - (2) The Service shall consist of-
 - (a) such persons as were appointed, absorbed or promoted against the post of Assistant Director and above as shown in the Schedule on or before 21st August, 1975 and subsequently regularised by the Commission;
 - (b) such persons as were appointed or promoted after the 21st August, 1975, against the post of Medical Officer (MCH)/(MST)/(Clinics) in the scale of Tk. 900—1610 and who have no lien in any other service or post of the Government;
 - (c) such persons as were appointed or promoted after the 21st August, 1975, against the posts of Family Planning Officers in the scale of Tk. 750—1470 or above as shown in the Schedule and subsequently regularised by the Commission; and
 - (d) persons to be appointed to the Service in accordance with relevant recruitment rules.
- 4. Posts borne in the cadre.—(1) The posts specified in Schedule shall be borne in the cadre of the Service and the initial cadre strength of the Service shall be as shown in the Schedule.
- (2) The cadre strength of the Service may be varied by the Government from time to time.
- Appointing Authority.—Appointment to the Service shall be made by the President or an officer authorised by him.
