# Dacca, the 28th November 1981

No. S.R.O. 383-L/81/476-Poll(I).—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Explosives Act, 1884 (IV of 1884), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in this Ministry's Notification No. S.R.O. 318-L/81/379-Poll(I), dated the 17th September 1981, namely:-

In the aforesaid Notification, in the first paragraph, in the proviso, for the full stop at the end a colon shall be substituted and thereafter the following second proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided further that the match manufacturing industries in Bangladesh shall be exempt from the operation of the prohibition under this Notification. and the two Notifications referred to above so that they may import, transport and possess essential items of explosives required for the manufacture of safety matches within the limits of the whole of Bangladesh".

2. This Notification shall come into force on the date of its publication in the official Gazette.
