NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 31st August, 1985

No. S. R. O. 389-L/85.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 8 of the Bangladesh Coinage Order, 1972 (P.O. No. 83 of 1972), the Government is pleased to declare that the Pakistani half-rupee coins, fifty paise coins, quarter-rupee coins, twenty-five paise coins, ten paise coins, five paise coins, two paise coins and one paise coins issued under the authority of the Government of Pakistan before the 26th day of March, 1971, and thereafter issued under the authority of the Government shall cease to be legal tender in Bangladesh with effect on and from the 15th September, 1985.

These coins shall, however, be received and exchange value paid across the counter of the offices of the Bangladesh Bank at Dhaka, Chittagong, Khulna, Bogra, Rajshahi, Sylhet and Sonali Bank branches performing treasury functions up to 30th September, 1985 during banking hours.
