# NOTIFICATION

# Dhaka, the 21st November 1982

No. S.R.O. 394-L/82/ED(R-II)R-70/80.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Chief Martial Law Administrator is pleased to make the following amendments in the Bangladesh Civil Service Recruitment Rules, 1981, namely:—

In the aforesaid rules, after rule 9, the following new rule shall be added, namely:—

"10. Recruitment of Munsif to meet urgent situation.—(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules or in any other rules for the time being in force, the Government may, in order to meet urgent situation due to creation of upgraded thanas, make appointment to the Bangladesh Civil Service (Judicial) for recruitment to the post of Munsif, not exceeding one hundred, specified in the Schedule on the basis of viva voce test conducted by the Government.

- (2) The age limit of the candidates for appointment under sub-rule(1) shall be 35 years.
- (3) All rules for appointment by direct recruitment to the Bangladesh Civil Service (Judicial) shall, in so far as they are not inconsistent with this rule, apply to such appointment.".
