No. S.R.O. 428-L/84.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following amendment in the Gazetted Officers (Directorate of Population Control and Family Planning) Recruitment Rules, 1976, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,—

(a) in rule 1, the words “and Family Planning” shall be *omitted*;

(b) in the Schedule,—

(i) in the heading relating to column (3), the words “for direct recruitment to the post” shall be *omitted*;

(ii) for Sl. No. 16 in column (1) and the entries relating thereto in columns (2), (3), (4) and (5) the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“16. Family Planning Officer.	Not exceeding 25 years, relaxable up to 35 years in case of departmental candidates.	For direct recruitment: Second Class Master’s Degree. Preference will be given to candidates having experience in motivation, education, communication, Community Organisation or Social Welfare activities.	(i) 70% by direct recruitment. (ii) 30% by promotion from amongst Assistant Family Planning Officers.
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For promotion : 3 years’ experience as Assistant Family Planning Officer.

16A. Assistant Family Planning Officer. Maximum 25 years relaxable up to 30 years in case of departmental candidates. *For direct recruitment:* (i) 50% by direct recruitment. Second Class Master's Degree.

*For promotion:* (i) 5 years' experience in a feeder post for posts specified in entry (ii) of column (5). (ii) 10% by promotion from amongst Field Trainers and Superintendents.

(ii) 7 years' experience in the feeder post specified in entry (iii) of column (5). (iii) 5% by promotion from Health Inspectors.

(iii) 7 years' experience in a feeder post for posts specified in entry (iv) of column (5). (iv) 10% by promotion from amongst Head Assistant, Stenographers, Upper Division Assistant of offices other than Upazilla offices, Accountants, Research Assistants, Auditors, Stenotypists, Cashiers, Store Keepers and Coder Editors.

(iv) 10 years' experience in a feeder post for posts specified in entry (v) of column(5). (v) 20% by promotion from amongst Family Planning Assistants (Union level) and Family Planning Assistant/Upper Division Assistants of Upazila offices.

(v) 10 years' experience in the feeder post specified in entry (vi) of column (5). (vi) 5% by promotion from Family Welfare Visitors (FWV)."

(iii) against Sl. No. 19 in column (1), in column (5) in item (i), after the word "Supervisor" the comma and the word "Home

Economist" shall be *substituted* and shall be deemed always to have been substituted; and

- (iv) after Sl. No. 26 in column (1) and the entries relating thereto, the following Explanation shall be *added*, namely :—

*“Explanation.—For matter of qualification like “Master’s Degree”, “Bachelor’s Degree”, “MBBS”, “M.Com.” referred to in this schedule, the degree of a University established by or under any law for the time being in force or such other University declared by the Government for this purpose shall be recognised”.*
