NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 8th October 1985

No. S. R. O. 434-L/85/ME/Rectt/1-51(Vol. 2)/83.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Bangladesh Civil Service (Age, Qualification and Examination for Direct Recruitment) Rules, 1982, namely :—

In the aforesaid Rules,—

- (1) in rule 4, for the words “and Khulna” the commas and words, “,Khulna, London and Washington” shall be substituted;
- (2) in rule 13,—
 - (a) in sub-rule (1), for the figure “25” the figure “27” shall be substituted; and
 - (b) in sub-rule (2), for the words and brackets “Bangladesh Civil Service (Health and Family Planning)” the words, brackets and colon “Bangladesh Civil Service (Health and Family Planning : Health)” shall be substituted;

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(3) for rule 18 the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“18. Subjects and distribution of marks.—(1) The examination for recruitment to a Service/a cadre post in a Service specified in serial numbers 1, 2(a), 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 29 and 30 of Schedule I shall consist of the following:—

(a) Five papers on compulsory subjects	..	500 marks
(b) Three papers on optional subjects	..	300 marks
(c) Psychological test	..	Pass/Fail
(d) <i>Viva Voce</i> test	..	200 marks
Total		.. 1000 marks

(2) The examination for recruitment to a Service/a cadre post in a Service specified in serial numbers 2(b), 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 28 of Schedule I shall consist of the following:—

(a) Five papers on compulsory subjects	..	500 marks
(b) Academic attainments	..	300 marks
(c) Psychological test	..	Pass/Fail
(d) <i>Viva Voce</i> test	..	200 marks
Total		.. 1000 marks”;

(4) in rule 19, for sub-rule (1) the following shall be *constituted*, namely:—

“(1) No candidate shall be allowed to offer more than two subjects from any of the Groups mentioned in PART ‘B’ of Schedule II.”;

(5) for rule 20 the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“20. Minimum qualifying marks.—(1) The minimum qualifying marks shall be 45% in aggregate in written examination and 40% in *Viva Voce* test:

Provided that, if necessary, the Commission may, with the prior approval of the Government, reduce or enhance the minimum aggregate qualifying marks.

(2) The pass/fail in Psychological test shall be decided by the Commission on the basis of the policy formulated by the Commission in this regard.

(3) A candidate securing less than 25% marks in any compulsory or optional subject shall be deemed to have secured no marks in that subject.”;

(6) for rule 22 the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“22. Psychological and *Viva Voce* tests.—(1) Candidates qualifying in the written examination shall, after the announcement of the result of such examination, be required to appear at the Psychological test designed to assess their personal qualities and traits of character with special regard to their aptitude for the post.

(2) Each successful candidate, after Psychological test, shall be interviewed by a Board to be constituted by the Commission in this behalf. The Board shall attach particular importance to the intelligence, alertness of mind, vigour, strength of character and potential qualities of leadership of the candidates. The Board shall take into consideration extra-curricular activities, such as, sports, debates, hobbies, etc., of the candidates.”;

(7) in rule 23, for sub-rule (1) the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) Candidates qualifying in the written examination, psychological and *viva voce* tests shall be required to appear before a Medical Board for physical examination.”;

(8) in Schedule I,—

(a) for Sl. Nos. 1, 2 and 3 in column 1 and the entries relating thereto in columns 2, 3 and 4 the following shall be substituted, namely :—

1. Bangladesh Civil Service (Administrative : Administrative).	Assistant Commissioner	A degree with Second Class/Division or degree with First Division in the S.S.C. or H. S. C. or an equivalent examination or Post Graduation degree with Second Class.

3. Bangladesh Civil Service (Finance: Audit and Accounts).	Assistant Accountant General/Assistant Controller of Military Accounts/Assistant Controller of Air Force Accounts/ Assistant Controller Neval Accounts/Accounts Officer/Additional Divisional Accounts Officer/ Finance Officer/ Chief Cashier and Pay Master (Railway).	A degree with Second Class/Division or degree with First Division in the S. S. C. or H. S. C. or an equivalent examination or Post-Graduation degree with Second Class.”;

(b) for Sl. No. 5 in column 1 and the entries relating thereto in columns 2, 3 and 4 the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“5. Bangladesh Civil Service (Finance: Taxation).	Assistant Commissioner of Taxes/ Tax Recovery Officer/ Assistant Director.	Ditto.”;
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(c) for Sl. No. 9 in column 1 and the entries relating thereto in columns 2, 3 and 4 the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“9. Bangladesh Civil-Service (Enforcement : Ansar).	Assistant District Adjutant of Ansars and Village Defence/Deputy Assistant Director of Ansars and Village Defence/Battalion Second-in-Command of Ansars.	Ditto.”;
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(d) for Sl. No. 12, 13, 14 and 15 in column 1 and the entries relating thereto in columns 2, 3 and 4 the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“12. Bangladesh Civil Service (Agriculture: Agriculture).

(A) <i>Department of Agricultural Extension.</i>	Subject Matter Officer/ Additional Agriculture Officer/Aerial Pest Control Officer/Entomologist/Plant Pathologist/Quarantine Entomologist/Instructor/ Assistant Horticulturist/ Chemist/Field Officer/ Seed Analyst/Sample Collection Officer/Publication Officer.	Degree with Honours in Agriculture.
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(B) <i>Department of Agricultural Marketing.</i>	Assistant Director/ Research Officer.	First Class Master's degree in any branch of Commerce or in Economics with Economics in degree level or Second Class Master's degree with Second Class Honours in any branch of Commerce or in Economics or in Statistics with Economics
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at degree level or Second Class Master's degree in Agricultural Economics or in Agricultural Marketing or Master's degree in Business Administration.

(C) *Soil Resources Development Institute.* Scientific Officer

(a) First Class Master's degree in Soil Science or Second Class Master's degree with Second Class Honours in Soil Science or Second Class Master's degree in Agriculture in Soil Science or Second Class Master's degree in Agriculture in Agricultural Chemistry.

OR

(b) Degree with Honours in Agriculture.

13. Bangladesh Civil Service (Agriculture: Forest). Assistant Conservator of Forest. First Class Master's degree or Second Class Master's degree with Second Class Honours in Physics or in Chemistry or in Botany or in Zoology or in Soil Science or Honours degree in Forestry.

14. Bangladesh Civil Service (Agriculture : Fisheries). (a) Upazila Fisheries Officer. Degree with Honours in Fisheries.

(b) Assistant Training Officer/Curator/Research Officer/Biologist/Aquaculturist/Fisheries Extension Officer/Project Officer/Bio-Metrician/Deputy Assistant Director/Deputy Fish Culturist/Technical Officer. (i) Degree with Honours in Fisheries.

OR

(i) First Class Master's degree or Second Class Master's degree with Second Class Honours in Zoology (Fisheries Group).

- (c) Fisheries Technologist/ Gear Technologist/ Technologist. First Class Master's degree or Second Class Master's degree with Second Class Honours in Chemistry or in Bio-Chemistry or in Applied Chemistry.
15. Bangladesh Civil Service (Agriculture : Livestock). Upazila Livestock Officer Veterinary Surgeon/ Veterinary Assistant Surgeon/Animal Production Officer/ Assistant Poultry Extension Officer/ Poultry Development Officer/Officer-in-charge (Zoo-museum)/Animal Nutrition Officer/Zoo Officer/Scientific Officer/ Publicity Officer/Store Officer/Lecturer, Veterinary Training Institute. Second Class degree in Veterinary Science or Animal Husbandry (vig., Doctor of Veterinary Medicine/BSc. Animal Husbandry (Honours)/B.S/c. Animal Husbandry B.Sc. Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry from a recognised University” ;

(e) for Sl. No. 21 in column 1 and the entries relating thereto in columns 2, 3 and 4 the following shall be *substituted*, namely :—

- “21. Bangladesh Civil Service (Health and Family Planning : Health). Assistant Surgeon M.B.B.S. degree or its equivalent.
- 21A. Bangladesh Civil Service (Health and Family Planning : Family Planning). Family Planning Officer .7”;

(9) for Schedule II the following shall be *substituted*, namely :—
