No. S.R.O. 450-L/85/ME/Recit/1.51(Volume-2)/83.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Bangladesh Civil Service (Age, Qualification and Examination for Direct Recruitment) Rules, 1982, namely :—

In the aforesaid Rules, *after* rule 18B, the following new rule shall be *inserted*, namely :—

“18C. Recruitment to meet urgent situation.—(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules or in any other rules for the time being in force, the Government may, in order to meet urgent situation, make a further one-time recruitment to the entry level posts of the Bangladesh
