(*Customs and Sales Tax*)

NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 12th November, 1984

No. S.R.O. 494-L/84/881/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and section 4(1) of the Sales Tax Ordinance, 1982 (XVIII of 1982), the Government is pleased to exempt so much of customs-duties and sales tax as are in excess of 20% and 10% respectively on all articles imported for the Bangladesh Railway for the

purpose of maintenance and operation of the Railway and also for repair, replacement, improvement and development of railway workshops, carriages and wagons, locomotives, other rolling stocks, ferry vessels, signalling and telecommunication system, track and bridges provided that the Chief Controller of Stores, Bangladesh Railway certifies that the goods and articles are genuinely required by the Bangladesh Railway for the purposes mentioned above and the materials are cleared by Railways.
