**No. S.R.O. 512-L/84.**—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982 and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

**THE NON-CADRE OFFICERS AND STAFF OF ANSARS AND VILLAGE DEFENCE PARTY (DEPARTMENT OF ANSARS AND VILLAGE DEFENCE PARTY UNDER THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1984.**

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Non-Cadre Officers and Staff of Ansars and Village Defence Party (Department of Ansars and Village Defence Party under the Ministry of Home Affairs) Recruitment Rules, 1984.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) "appointing authority" means the authority shown in the Schedule-II (in relation to any specified post or class of such posts);
- (b) "probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (c) "recognised University" means a university established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other university declared by the Government, to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules;

- (d) "requisite qualification" in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the Schedule-I in relation to that post;
- (e) "Schedule" means the Schedules-I and II annexed to these rules;
- (f) "specified post" means a post specified in Schedule-I; and
- (g) "Committee" means a Committee specified in the Schedule-II for the purpose of selection of candidates for appointment to a specified post.

**3. Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provision of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation for the purpose of clause (3) of article 29 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment; or
- (b) by promotion, or
- (c) by transfer on deputation.

No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification for that post as laid down in Schedule-I and in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit laid down in Schedule for that post :

Provided that the upper limit of age may be relaxed in the case of a person who has already been appointed to a specified post on *ad hoc* basis by such period as he may have been holding the post continuously as an *ad hoc* appointee.

**4. Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) All appointments to the specified post by direct recruitment shall be made on the recommendation of the Committee specified in Schedule II.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh; and
- (b) is married to or has entered into a promise of marriage with a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by an authorised medical officer to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post;
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic;
- (c) no person selected for appointment to the specified posts as shown at Serial Nos. 31, 32 and 33 of Schedule-I shall be appointed to that specified post unless he has successfully completed a prescribed course of practical training for a period of 3 (three) months; and
- (d) during the period of training as in (c) above a candidate selected for appointment to such posts shall be entitled to such pay and allowances as may be fixed by the Government and those who shall not complete the course satisfactorily be discharged.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date as was notified while inviting application for the specified post; and
- (b) in the case of a person already in Government service of a local authority he applied through his official superior.

**5. Appointment by promotion.**—(1) Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may constitute in this behalf;

(2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post, if he has un-satisfactory records of service.

**6. Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment—for a period of 2(two) years from the date of substantive appointment; and
- (b) in the case of promotion—for a period of one year from the date of such appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods which will not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Where during the period of probation of a probationer the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may before the expiry of that period:—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
- (b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during the period of his probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provision of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and
- (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may—
  - (i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
  - (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, direct.

**No. S.R.O. 513-L/84.**—In pursuance of the Proclamation of 24th March 1982 and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President after consultation with the Public Service Commission is pleased to make the following rules namely :—

THE BANGLADESH RIFLES (CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1984.

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Bangladesh Rifles (Civilian Employees) Recruitment Rules, 1984.

2. **Definition.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) “appointing authority” means the Director General, Bangladesh Rifles on behalf of Government and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by the Director General to make appointment to such post or class of posts;
- (b) “probationer” means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (c) “requisite qualification” in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the schedule in relation to that post;
- (d) “recognised University” means a university established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes, any other university declared by the Government, after consultation with the commission, to be recognized university for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) “Schedule” means the schedule annexed to these rules, and
- (f) “specified post” means a post specified in the schedule.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the schedule and instructions relating to reservation [for the purpose of clause (3) of Article 29 of the Constitution of the People’s Republic of Bangladesh] appointment to a specified post shall be made :

- (a) By direct recruitment,
- (b) By promotion.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit laid down in the schedule for that post.

4. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the board constituted in this behalf.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of or domiciled in Bangladesh,

- (b) is married to or has entered into a promise of marriage with a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until the person selected for recruitment is certified medically fit by an authorised medical officer.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless he is qualified in the written oral test conducted by the board constituted by the authority.

(5) No person shall be recommended for appointment unless he appears before the selection board on the exact date and at exact time as it is notified.

(6) No person who is already in Government service or in the service of local authority shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless he applies through proper channel.

**5. Appointment by promotion.**—(1) Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made by a departmental promotion board on fulfilment of terms and conditions as laid down in the schedule.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has unsatisfactory records of service.

**6. Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation :—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and

- (b) in the case of promotion for a period of one year/six months from the date of such appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient it may, before the expiry of that period :—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and

- (b) in the case of promotion revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority :—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him, and

- (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may :—

- (i) in the case of direct recruitment terminate his service,

- (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until user units submit recommendation for confirmation.

7. **Verification of character and antecedents.**—On appointment by direct recruitment to a specified post, the character and antecedents of the person appointed will be verified through appropriate agency of the respective district. On receipt of the verification roll from the appropriate agency will be scrutinised and if there is no adverse report, the same will be kept pasted in the personal documents of the concerned individual. In case any adverse report is furnished by the agency, then the case will be dealt with as per decision of the appointing authority.
