No. S. R. O. 1-L/82/ED(IC)SII-2/80-1.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of Article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following amendment in the Bangladesh Civil Service (Administrative : Food) Composition and Cadre Rules, 1980, namely :—

In the aforesaid Rules, in rule 3, in sub-rule (2), for clause (b) the following shall be substituted and shall be deemed to have always been so substituted, namely :—

- “(b) persons appointed on regular basis, on or after the 26th day of March, 1971, on the recommendation of the erstwhile East Pakistan Public Service Commission or the Bangladesh Public Service (First) Commission or the Bangladesh Public Service (Second) Commission or the Commission or the competent authority during the period from the 16th day of December, 1971 to the 7th day of April, 1972, or during such period as the posts were taken outside the purview of any of the aforesaid Commissions, as the case may be, to the posts which would have been included in the cadre of the service had it not been treated as abolished

after independence and whose terms and conditions are governed by any former cadre service rules and persons appointed on regular basis on or after the 26th day of March, 1971, to the posts not belonging to the former cadre service but included in the Schedule ; and”.

No. S.R.O. 2-L/82.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of Article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following further amendments in the rules regulating the recruitment to the various subordinate services and posts in the Directorate and subordinate and other mufassil offices under the Ministry of Food, published under Notification No. FD/Estb.-1/4R-12/60/376, dated the 28th July 1960, namely:—

In the aforesaid rules, in Schedule 1 (Non-Gazetted Posts), against serial number 6,—

- (a) in column 2, in entry (iii), *after* the words “Subordinate Offices” at the end, the words “and Scaleman of the Government Flour and Feed Mills” shall be *inserted*; and
- (b) in column 3, in entries (ii) and (iii), *after* the letters, full-stop and word “L.D. Clerk” at the end, the words “or Scaleman” shall be *inserted*.
