

No. S.R.O. 17-L/77/S-VL/3R-1/77/34.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 86 of the Local Government Ordinance, 1976 (XC of 1976), the Government is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

# THE UNION PARISHADS AND THANA PARISHADS (OATH OF OFFICE) RULES, 1977.

- Short title.—These rules may be called the Union Parishads and Thana Parishads (Oath of Office) Rules, 1977.
- 2. Oath of Office of the Chairman and Members of Union Parishad.—
  Every Chairman and Member of a Union Parishad shall make an oath of office in Form I annexed to these rules in the office of the respective Union Parishad or at any other public place before the Circle Officer (Development) or any other officer as may be authorised by the Prescribed Authority and on such date, not beyond thirty days from the date of publication of the names of persons elected as Chairman and Members under section 25 of the Local Government Ordinance, 1976, as may be determined by the Prescribed Authority.
- (2) If the Chairman, for any reason, fails to make an oath of office on the date fixed by the Prescribed Authority under sub-rule (1), the Circle Officer (Development) or any officer authorised by him in this behalf shall administer the oath of office to such Chairman on a subsequent date if the Prescribed Authority extends the period for good cause shown.

- (3) If any member, for any reason, fails to make an oath of office on the date fixed by the Prescribed Authority under sub-rule (1), the Chairman or the person presiding at a subsequent meeting of the Union Parishad, shall administer the oath of office to such member if the Prescribed Authority extends the period for good cause shown.
- (4) Any person filling in a casual vacancy of the office of the Chairman or member of a Union Parishad shall, before he enters upon his office, the oath of office shall be administered to such person—
  - (a) in the case of Chairman, by the member elected to perform the functions of the Chairman; and
  - (b) in the case of member, by the Chairman or the member elected to perform the functions of the Chairman.
- 3. Oath of Office of the Members of the Thana Parishad.—(1) Every representative member and official member shall, in its first meeting, make an oath of office in Form II annexed to these rules. The Chairman or, in his absence, the Vice-Chairman of the respective Thana Parishad shall, before transacting any business in that meeting, make an oath of office first and then administer the same to every representative member and official member present:

Provided that if the Chairman is not present in the first meeting he shall make the oath of office on a subsequent date when he for the first time attends the meeting.

- (2) If any member is, for any reason, not present in the first meeting, the Chairman or the Vice-Chairman presiding at a subsequent meeting of the Thana Parishad shall administer the oath of office to such member.
- (3) Any member filling in a casual vacancy shall, before he enters upon his office, make the oath of office in the manner provided in this rule.

#### Dacca, the 13th January, 1977.

No. S.R.O. 20-L/77.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (i) of section 7 of the Sales Tax Act, 1951 (III of 1951), and in supersession of the Ministry of Finance Notification No. S.R.O.51(R), dated the 1st July, 1961, the Government is pleased to exempt from the tax payable under the said Act all such goods except the goods mentioned in the schedule below as are produced or manufactured in Bangladesh (including raw materials used in their production or manufacture) are sold for delivered outside Bangladesh and are actually so delivered.

#### Schedule.

- 1. Ginned cotton.
- Lizard skins, otter skins and reptile skins—whether raw, semi-processed or tanned.

No. S.R.O. 21-L/77.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (d) of sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Sales Tax Act, 1951 (III of 1951), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to direct that tax shall be levied and collected in respect of the goods specified below which are exported from Bangladesh, namely:

 Lizard skins, otter skins and reptile skins—whether raw, semi-processed or tanned.

No. S.R.O. 22-L/77.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 176A of the Army Act, 1952 (XXXIX of 1952), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Army Regulations. Volume-II (Instructions), namely:

In the aforesaid Regulations, for paragraph 153-A the following shall be substituted, namely:—

- "153-A. Services personnel granted Junior Commission in AEC. The seniority of JCOs recruited in AEC on the same date or in same batch will be determined on the basis of length of service and marks obtained by them in the examinations. The points for the length of service and examinations will be as follows:—
  - (a) Pre-commission service seniority ... 25 points.
  - (b) Entrance examinations results for recruitment of 25 points. JCOs in AEC.
  - (c) Conversion course examinations results ... 50 points.

Explanation-For the purpose of calculation of points:-

- (a) the individual who has the maximum length of service will be given 25 points and others will get points proportionate to the length of their individual service. The length of service will be counted from the date of enrolment. The length of service will be counted in whole numbers, any fraction thereof, if it is less than 6 months will not be taken into account, and if it is 6 months or more will be counted as the next whole number:
- (b) the individual who secures maximum marks in the entrance examinations shall be given 25 points. The other individuals will get points proportionate to marks obtained by them in the examinations;
- (c) the individual who secures maximum marks in the conversion course examinations will be given 50-points. The other individuals will get points proportionate to the marks obtained by them in said examination. The individual getting maximum points out of (a), (b) and (c) combined together shall have the seniority over others in the batch. The position of others will be decided in a descending order with respect to the most senior man according to the points obtained by each. In case more than one person obtain the same number of points, their seniority will be fixed on the basis of their length of service. The person having more service will be placed above the other".
