NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 2nd March, 1978.

No. S.R.O. 44-L/78/RHE/6P-2/78/195.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely :

**THE SENIOR ECONOMIST (ROADS AND HIGHWAYS DEPARTMENT)
RECRUITMENT RULES, 1977.**

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Senior Economist (Roads and Highways Department) Recruitment Rules, 1977.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission ;
- (b) "Post" means the post of Senior Economist of the Roads and Highways Department ;
- (c) "recognised University" means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other University declared by Government, after consultation with the Commission to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules ;
- (d) "requisite qualification" means the qualification specified in column 4 of the Schedule ; and

(e) "Schedule" means the schedule to these rules.

3. Procedure of recruitment.—(1) Subject to the provisions of the schedule, appointment to the post shall be made—

(a) by promotion from amongst the Economists of the Roads and Highways Department; or

(b) by direct recruitment.

(2) No person shall be appointed to the post unless he has the requisite qualification, and in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit, if any, specified in the Schedule for the post.

4. Appointment by promotion.—Appointment by promotion to the post shall be made by the Government upon the recommendation of the Superior Selection Board constituted by the Government.

5. Appointment by direct recruitment.—(1) No appointment to the post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment if he—

(a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Bangladesh;

(b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to the post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

(a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the post; and

(b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

- Provided that if none is found suitable for appointment by direct recruitment, the post may be filled in by promotion or by transfer of Service on deputation from other Government Offices.
- (a) First Class Master's Degree in Economics or Transport Economics or Commerce or Statistics with Second Class Honours Degree from a recognised University ; and
- (b) Seven years' experience of which at least five years shall be in transport economics or economic planning and evaluation of transport projects ;

OR

- (a) Ph.D. in any of the above subjects ; and
- (b) Five years' experience of which at least two years shall be in transport economics or economic planning and evaluation of transport projects.
