No. S.R. 0.54-L/77.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to A t cle 133 of the Constitution, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service (First) Commission as required by clause (2) of Article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to direct that the following amendment shall be made and shall be deemed to have been so made with effect from the 17th December, 1971, in the Foreign Service (Pay, Allowances, Leave, etc.) Rules, 1962, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules, in rule 23, for clause (b) the following shall be substituted, namely:—

(b) "By air

If an officer is authorised by the Government to travel by air on transfer, he shall be allowed the cost of transportation by air or by air in combination with train, steamer or other craft of his personal effects up to maxima prescribed not exceeding the cost of transportation of maximum permissible personal effects admissible under clause (a)".

2. No financial benefit accrued on account of giving retrospective effect to this notification shall be paid in foreign currency.
