No. S.R O. 58-L/77/324/D/Cus/77.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and in supersession of S.R.O. 146, dated the 24th April 1974, the Government is pleased to exempt appliances, apparatus and accessories used in athletics, gymnastics and the games of football, vollyball, hockey, table tennis, badminton, carrom, cricket and lawn tennis from the whole of the customs-duty chargeable thereon and those used in the games of billiard and golf from so much of the customs-duty as is in excess of 36% advalorem provided it is established to the satisfaction of an officer of customs not below the rank of an Assistant Collector that the goods have no use except in games and sports.

This notification shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 17th day of January 1977.

No. S.R.O. 61-L/77.—WHEREAS an incident involving firing took place on 28th January, 1977, at Khepupara in the district of Patuakhali over the removal of a power generator from Khepupara to Patuakhali resulting in injury and death to some persons;

AND WHEREAS the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary to appoint a Commission of Inquiry for the purpose of making an inquiry into the said incident which is a matter of public importance.

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Commission of Inquiry Act, 1956 (VI of 1956), the Government is pleased to appoint a Commission of Inquiry consisting of Mr Justice M. N. Huda, at present Chairman, Screening Board to enquire into said incident.

The terms of reference of the Commission of Inquiry are as follows:

(1) to enquire into the circumstances under which the power generator was shifted from Khepupara to Patuakhali and whether there was any justification for it;

- (2) to ascertain whether any replacement for the said generator was necessary and if so, what arrangement was made for it;
- (3) to enquire whether there were genuine grievances of the local people against removal of the said generator and to ascertain whether such grievances were kept in view before the generator was removed;
- (4) to enquire into the circumstances leading to the firing in the above incident which caused injury and death to some persons:
- (5) to ascertain whether the firing was done by the police and, if so, whether there was sufficient justification for it:
- (6) to identify, if the said firing was not done by the police, the persons who were responsible for the same and their motives therefor:
- (7) to determine, whether subsequent to the incident, the District Administration or any other agency of the Government resorted to any harassment or victimisation of the people of Khepupara;
- (8) to enquire whether there was any justification for the arrest of the local people after the incident; and
- (9) to ascertain whether there was any Civil Court injunction against removal of the generator and whether the same was known to the District Administration.

The Commission shall submit its report to the Government by 28th February, 1977.

No. 11-MLC.—Whereas it has been made to appear to this Court that (1) Abdul Momin Bhuiya, Store-in-charge, Thana Store, Feni, Bangladesh Consumers Supplies Corporation, son of Abul Bashar Bhuiya, Vill. Ruhitia, P.S. Feni, Dist, Noakhali, is required for the purpose of trial in the Summary Martial Law Court under MLR 11 of 1975;

And whereas this Court has reasons to believe that the said accused person is absconding or concealing himself to avoid appearance or arrest for the said purpose.

Now, therefore in exercise of the powers conferred by Martial Law Regulation 3(7) of MLR I of 1975, this Summary Martial Law Court, Feni, do hereby direct—

The aforesaid accused to appear in this Court within the seven days from the date of publication of this Notification failing which he will be tried in absentia and his properties may be forfeited to the Government.
