Dhaka, the 17th February 1986

No. S.R.O. 58-L/86/ME (Regn-V) RR-21/85.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Bangladesh Civil Service Recruitment Rules, 1981, namely :—

In the aforesaid Rules, in Schedule II, in Part-XII, for Sl. Nos. 3, 4 and 5 in column 1 and the entries relating thereto the following shall be *substituted*, namely :—

“3. Superintending Engineer.

By promotion from amongst Executive Engineers and Assistant Chief Engineers.

(i) Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or its equivalent in the relevant field from a recognised University or passed Sections A and B of A.M.I.E.; and

(ii) 12 years' experience in the relevant field of the concerned Service including 5 years' experience in the feeder post or posts specified in column 4.
