No. S.R.O. 58-L/86/ME (Regn-V) RR-21/85.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Bangladesh Civil Srervice Recruitment Rules, 1981, namely:—

In the aforsaid Rules, in Schedule II, in Part-XII, for Sl. Nos. 3, 4 and 5 in column 1 and the entries relating thereto the following shall be substituted, namely:—

"3. Superintending Engineer. By promotion from amongst Executive Engineers and Assistant Chief Engineers.

- (i) Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or its equivalent in the relevant field from a recognised University or passed Sections A and B of A.M.I.E.; and
- (ii) 12 years' experience in the relevant field of the concerned Service including 5 years' experience in the feeder post or posts specified in column 4.

- 4. Executive Engineer/ Assistant Chief Engineer.
- Sub-Divisional Engineer.

- By promotion from amongst the Sub-Divisional Engineers.
- 7 years' experience in the relevant field of the concerned Service.
- By promotion from amongst the Assistant Engineers, and if none is found suitable for promotion, by direct recruitment,

For promotion: 4 years' experience in the relevant field of the concerned Service.

Not exceeding 30 years, relaxable up to 35 years for persons already in Government Service.

For direct recruitment:

- (i) Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or its equivalent in the relevant field from a recognised University or passed Sections A and B of A.M.I.E.; and
- (ii) 4 years' experience as Assistant Engineer in the relevant field.

Assistant Engineer. 1/3rd by promotion from amongst the Sub-Assistant Engineers, and Estimators.

For promotion:

- (i) Diploma in Engineuring in the relevant field from an Institution recognised by the Government; and
- (ii) 5 years' experience in a feeder post or posts specified in column 4.

As per rules prescribed in the B.C.S. (Age, Qualification and Examination for Direct Recruitment) Rules, 1982. 2/3rds by direct recruitment.

For direct recruitment:
As per rules prescribed in the B.C.S. (Age, Qualification and Examination for Direct Recruitment) Rules, 1982."
