- “12.07 (i) Agar wood, including its cuttings, falling under sub-head A 35% *Ad val.*
(ii) Goods of a kind used primarily in pharmacy falling under sub-head B Nil.”

No. S.R.O. 70-L/82/LIUVII/18(1)/82.—Whereas the workers of the Arco Industries Limited, Chittagong, have gone on strike with effect from the 15th December, 1981;

And whereas the said strike has lasted for more than thirty days;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 32 of the Industrial Relations Ordinance, 1969 (XXIII of 1969), the Government is pleased to prohibit the said strike of the workers of the Arco Industries Limited, Chittagong, and to refer their disputes to the Labour Court, Chittagong, for adjudication in pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (3) of that section.
