NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 11th February, 1985

No. S.R.O. 77-L/85.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of 24th day of March 1982 and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make in supersession of all previous recruitment rules, the following rules, namely :—

THE GAZETTED AND NON-GAZETTED EMPLOYEES (DEPARTMENT OF FISHERIES) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1984.

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Gazetted and Non-Gazetted Employees (Department of Fisheries) Recruitment Rules, 1984.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context—

- (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by Government to make appointment to such posts or class of posts;
- (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) "probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;

- (d) "Recognised University or Board" means a University or Board established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any institution declared by Government after consultation with the Commission to be a recognised University or Board for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) "requisite qualification" in relation to a specified post means the qualification prescribed in the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (f) "Schedule" means a Schedule attached to these rules;
- (g) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule.

3. Procedure for requirement.—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation and quota, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment, or
- (b) by promotion, or
- (c) by transfer on deputation.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualifications, and in the case of direct recruitment, he is within the age limit, if any, prescribed in the Schedule for that post.

(3) Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Government may in consideration of experience and merits and with the concurrence of the Commission, relax in any exceptional case to such extent and subject to such conditions, if any, as it may deem fit, any of the requirements of these rules.

4. Appointment by direct recruitment.—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh; and
- (b) is married to a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified in the case of Gazetted Officer by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director General of Health Services and in the case of non-Gazetted employee by an authorised Medical Officer that he is medically fit for such appointment and he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment to Government Service.

5. Appointment by promotion.—(1) Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of the Superior Selection Board or, as the case may be, of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may constitute in this behalf:

Provided that appointment by promotion to a specified post of higher class shall be made on the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has unsatisfactory records of service.

6. Probation.—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation,—

(a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and

(b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory and that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period,—

(a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and

(b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation the appointing authority,—

(a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during the period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and

(b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may,—

(i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and

(ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, direct.

NOTIFICATION

No. S.R.O. 78-L/85.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 44 (4) (b) of the Income Tax Ordinance, 1984 (XXXVI of 1984), the Government is pleased to exempt from the tax payable under the said Ordinance so much of the total income of expatriate personnel employed by tea industry and tea brokers in Bangladesh as is received or deemed to be received by, or accruing or arising or deemed to accrue or arise to them as overseas allowance in Bangladesh during the period of three years on and from the 1st day of July, 1984.

2. The portion of the total income exempted under the first paragraph shall be to the extent of overseas allowance, actually paid but not in excess of one-half of the basic salary or Taka 3,500 per month whichever is the less.

No. S.R.O. 79-L/85.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982 and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE GAZETTED OFFICERS AND STAFF (PATENT OFFICE) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1984.

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Gazetted Officers and Staff (Patent Office) Recruitment Rules, 1984.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to such post or class of posts;
- (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) "probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;

- (d) "recognised University or Board" means a University or Board established by or under the law for the time being in force and includes any other University or Board declared by the Government after consultation with the Commission, to be a recognised University or Board for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) "requisite qualification" in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the schedule in relation to that post;
- (f) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these rules; and
- (g) "Specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation for the purpose, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment; or
- (b) by promotion.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit laid down in the schedule for that post.

4. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh or a permanent resident of Bangladesh;
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh:

Provided that this clause shall not apply in the case of a person who is already in the service of the Republic.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made unless—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified in the case of Gazetted post, by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director General of Health Services and in the case of non-Gazetted post, by an authorised Medical Officer, that he is medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the specified post; and
- (b) in the case of a person already in the service of the Republic or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

5. Appointment by promotion.—(1) Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of the Superior Selection Board or, as the case may be by such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may constitute in this behalf:

Provided that appointment by promotion to a specified post of higher class shall be made on the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has unsatisfactory records of service.

6. Probation.—(1) A person selected for appointment to a specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation,—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and
- (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period,—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
- (b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule(4) confirm him; and

(b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during the period was not satisfactory, may,—

(i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and

(ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, direct.

No. S.R.O. 80-L/85/905/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in this Ministry's Notification No. S.R.O. 287-L/84/845/Cus., dated the 27th June, 1984, namely:—

In the aforesaid Notification, in the Table,—
