No. S.R.O. 96-L/82/S-XI/MWB-53/81/83.—In pursuance of the proviso to sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Minimum Wages Ordinance, 1961 (XXXIX of 1961), the Government is pleased to appoint the following members to be added to the Minimum Wages Board, established under said sub-section (1) for the purpose of discharging its function in respect of making recommendation for minimum rates of wages for the workers employed in the rubber industry in Bangladesh, namely:—
