No. Gen/1M/5/77/260.—The Government has constituted a one-man enquiry committee with Mr Kaiser Ali, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Law to enquire into the affairs of Sir Salimullah Medical College and the strike by students there.

Terms of Reference.

1. The Committee will make a thorough probe into the following matters:
 - (i) Facilities available in the College in respect of accommodation, library, recreation, teaching staff, hospital beds, etc., to run a regular M.B.B.S. Course. (The college was earlier running Condensed M.B.B.S. Course).
 - (ii) Proper utilization of teaching hours in clinical and pre-clinical sides in the college and the hospital.
 - (iii) Involvement of teachers in the welfare of the students.
 - (iv) Administrative problems in the college.
 - (v) Causes of the recent sudden strike in the college after the theoretical examination.
 - (vi) Any other related matter.
2. The Committee will submit its report as early as possible.
