S. R. O. No. ১০৭-আইন/৯৬—Army Act, 1952 (XXXIX of 1952) এর section-176A তে প্রদত্ত ক্ষমতাবলে সরকার Army Regulations (Rules) (Volume-I) এর নিম্নরূপ অধিকতর সংশোধন করিল, যথাঃ—

উপর-উক্ত Regulations (Rules) এর Rule-262 এর পরিবর্তে নিম্নরূপ Rule-262 প্রতিস্থাপিত হইবে, যথাঃ—

**“262 Age/Service limits for retirement of commissioned officers of Army**

1. Subject to the provision of rule 255, an officer shall, unless he exercises option under clause-3 below on completion of service limit specified in the Table below, retire from service on completion of the age limit specified in that Table.

Provided that a Lieutenant General shall retire from the service on attainment of 57 years of age or on completion of four years of service in the rank, whichever occurs first but not before attainment of 55 years of age, except tenure appointment.

Provided that a Major General shall retire from the service on attainment of 60 years of age or on completion of four years of service in the rank, whichever occurs first, but he shall not retire before the attainment of 57 years of age. Post of Director General Medical Services will be attainable by the officers of both the specialist as well as non-specialist category of AMC.

2. The tenure in the appointment of the Chief of the Army Staff will continue to be governed by S.R.O. 235-L/81/2C-S-1/81/D-1 dated 8th July 1981, S.R.O. No. 391-L/82/2C-S-1/81/D-1 dated 24th November 1982, S.R.O. No. 491-L/84 dated 12th November 1984 and S.R.O. No. 68-L/96 dated 28th May, 1996.

3. a. An officer intending to retire from service on completion of service limit specified in clause-I above may exercise his option to do so by serving a notice of his intention in writing to the Government at least six months prior to the date of such completion. The option once exercised shall be irrevocable subject to acceptance thereof by the Government.

b. Chief of the Army Staff may, if he is satisfied that an officer who has completed the service limit specified in clause-I above but not opted for retirement should be retired from service in the public interest, recommend to the Government for considering the case of such officer for retirement.

**Right of Government to Retire any Officer.**

4. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Regulations the Government may retire any officer at any time without assigning any reason whatsoever.

**Overriding effect of this Rule.**

5. These amendments will amend, wherever applicable, all previous terms and conditions etc. of AI(B) 3/88. In case of any discrepancy, with regards to adjustment of seniority of service between officers commissioned earlier and after this order or any related matters of these amendments, decisions to be taken by Army Headquarters as and when necessary.

*Note:* For the purpose of this rule, the term "Service" means commissioned service including any service forfeited as a result of Court Martial or any other departmental proceedings."
