NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 26th May 1978.

No. S.R.O. 121-L/78.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 60 of the Income-tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922), the Government is pleased to exempt from the tax payable under the said Act so much of the income of expatriate personnel of the Canadian International Development Agency working in Bangladesh under the terms of the 'Memorandum of Understanding', dated the 26th August, 1977, between the Government of Canada and the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, as represents payments made to them out of the Canadian contribution to the project and income earned outside Bangladesh.

Whereas, it has been made to appear to the Court that accused (1) Aatur Rahman, son of Kalai Hussain Bhuiya, Vill. Golabari, P.S. Kaliganj, Dacca, at present Asstt., Sonar Bangla Jute Mills, (2) A. K. M. Joynal Abedin, son of Alhaj Nazaruddin Sardar, Vill. Bagra, P. S. Brahmanbaria, Dist. Comilla, at present Accountant, Nabarun Jute Mills, (3) A. I. Mamoon, son of Hafizuddin Ahmed of 31, Bejoynagar, Dacca, at present Asstt. Manager, Bangladesh Jute Mills, Ghorashal, Dacca, (4) Syed Sadarullah, son of Syed Sikandar Hussain, P.O., P.S and Dist. Chittagong, at present Task Force, Dacca Zone, B.J. M.C., are required for the purpose of trial in the Summary Martial Law Court, Dacca under MLR 11/9 in connection with Kaliganj P. S. Case No. 6(3)77;

And whereas the Court has reason to believe that the said accused persons are absconding and concealing themselves to avoid appearance or arrest for the said purpose;

The aforesaid accused persons are directed to appear in the Summary Martial Law Court, Dacca Collectorate Court Building, Dacca, on 29th May 1978 at 09 30 hours, failing which they will be tried *in absentia* and their properties part/whole may be confiscated to the State.
