NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 27th April, 1981

No. S.R.O. 130-L/81/CAS-1/14(1)72/Pt.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Civil Aviation Ordinance, 1960 (XXXII of 1960), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Aircraft Rules, 1937, the same having been previously published as required by sub-section (2) of section 15 of the said Ordinance, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,

(1) for rule 81A the following shall be substituted, namely:

“81A. Fees for the use of Airport, etc.—(1) Every passenger embarking a scheduled or non-scheduled aircraft at an airport or aerodrome shall pay a fee for the use of, and for services provided at, such airport or aerodrome at the following rates, namely:—

- (a) where the destination is outside Bangladesh .. Tk. 100·00  
(b) where the destination is within Bangladesh. .. Tk. 10·00

Provided that the provisions of sub-rule (1) shall not apply to the following passengers, namely:—

- (a) Heads of States and Governments and their entourage;  
(b) Ministers and high dignitaries of foreign countries visiting Bangladesh as state guests;

- (c) transit passengers leaving Bangladesh by the same aircraft boarding which they entered the country or by the next available flight by which they have to reach their destination provided a scheduled night stop is not involved;
- (d) children under two years of age.

(2) No person in-charge of an aircraft shall allow any passenger to whom sub-rule (1) applies to board the aircraft unless such passenger has paid the fee payable under the sub-rule.

(3) The fee payable by a passenger under sub-rule (1) shall be collected in cash or by affixing special stamp on the air ticket."

This will have immediate effect.

No. SRO. 131-L/81/SIV/LC-52/81/200.—In partial modification of this Ministry's Notification No. SRO. 201-L/80/SIV/LC-10/80/152, dated the 24th June 1980 and in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 35 of the Industrial Relations Ordinance, 1969 (Ord. XXIII of 1969), the Government is pleased to establish the following Labour Courts as mentioned in column 1 of the Table below with the territorial limits specified in column 2 of the said Table within which each one of them shall exercise jurisdiction under the said Ordinance, namely:—

3. Third Labour Court, Dacca.	<p>3. The whole of Bangladesh in respect of cases falling within the jurisdiction of more than one Labour Court, except as provided in paragraph 2.</p> <p>1. The whole of Bangladesh in respect of all cases arising out of non-implementation of the Newspaper Employees Wage Board Award of 1977.</p> <p>2. Tongi police station of Gazipur subdivision and Narayangonj subdivision of Dacca district.</p> <p>3. Mymensingh district.</p>
4. Labour Court, Chittagong	The whole of the Chittagong Division.
5. Labour Court, Khulna	The whole of Khulna Division.
6. Labour Court, Rajshahi	The whole of Rajshahi Division.

2. No Labour Court, except the Third Labour Court, Dacca, shall have jurisdiction over the cases arising out of non-implementation of the Newspaper Employees Wage Board Award of 1977.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Notification, all cases pending in a Labour Court immediately before the issuance of this Notification shall continue to be proceeded with in the Courts where these cases are pending.
