**No. 337-Pub.**—The following Regulation made by the President and Chief Martial Law Administrator of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, on the 13th April, 1976, is hereby published for general information:—

**THE OFFENCES AGAINST THE STATE (SPECIAL PROVISIONS)  
REGULATION, 1976.**

**Martial Law Regulation No. XIII of 1976.**

WHEREAS it is expedient to make a Martial Law Regulation for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamations of the 20th August, 1975 and the 8th November, 1975, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Chief Martial Law Administrator is pleased to make the following Martial Law Regulation, namely:—

1. This Regulation may be called the Offences Against the State (Special Provisions) Regulation, 1976 and shall come into force at once.
2. In respect of any offence punishable under Chapter VI of the Penal Code, whether committed before or after the commencement of this Regulation, the provision of section 196 of the Code of Criminal Procedure shall not apply and shall be deemed never to have so applied.
