ORDER

Dacca, the 6th May, 1982

No. S.R.O. 140-L/82/227/MF/57/C-3/78.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Control of Essential Commodities Act, 1956 (E. P. Act I of 1956), the Government is pleased to make the following amendment in the Guest Control Order, 1978, issued by the erstwhile Ministry of Food under No. S.R.O. 311-L/78/737-MF/S-7/C-3/78, dated the 25th November, 1978, namely :—

In the aforesaid Order, in clause 3, for the full-stop at the end a colon shall be *substituted* and thereafter the following new proviso shall be *added*, namely:

“Provided that the Deputy Commissioner in connection with any religious function, may permit any person to distribute or serve or offer foodstuffs to persons in excess of one hundred.”
