Dhaka, the 23rd March 1985

No. S.R.O. 144-L/85.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 176A of the Army Act, 1952 (XXXIX of 1952), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Army Regulations (Rules), 1960, namely:—

In the said Regulation (Rules), *after* rule 288, the following new rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“288A. No officer, soldier or other person who is subject to the Army Act, 1952 (XXXIX of 1952), shall permit his wife, any child or any dependent to undertake or engage in any business, trade or commerce:—

Provided that the provision of this rule shall not apply to any business, trade or commerce legally inherited by his wife.”
