NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 26th May 1984

No S.R.O. 187-L/84 —In exercise of the powers conferred by section 23 of the Bangladesh Standards Institution Ordinance, 1977 (XXXIX of 1977), the Government, after consultation with the Bangladesh Standards Institutions,—

(a) is pleased to prohibit, with effect from 1st December 1984, the sale and distribution of the articles specified in column 2 of the Schedule below, unless they conform to the Bangladesh Standards specified in column 3 thereof; and

(b) is pleased to require that any article specified in the said Schedule which conforms to a particular Bangladesh Standard shall be marked with the Standard Mark.
