No. S. R. O. 216-L/77.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Censorship of Films Act, 1963 (XVIII of 1963), the Government is pleased to make the following amendment in the Bangladesh Censorship of Films Rules, 1977, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules, in rule 19, for sub-rule (2) the following shall be substituted, namely:—

"(2) Every film in respect of which an appeal is preferred shall be examined by an Appellate Committee which shall consist of the Secretary, Ministry of Cabinet Affairs (Cabinet Division) and such number of other members as may be appointed by the Government. The Secretary, Ministry of Cabinet Affairs (Cabinet Division) shall be the President of the Committee".
