NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 27th June 1981

No. S.R.O. 221-L/81.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called The Medical Assistants Recruitment Rules, 1981.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context.—

- (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to the post;
- (b) "National Medical Practitioner" means National Medical Practitioner registered with the Medical Council established under The Medical and Dental Council Act, 1980 (XVI of 1980);
- (c) "Probationer" means a person appointed on probation to the post; and
- (d) "post" means the post of Medical Assistant.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the instructions relating to reservation for the purpose of clause (3) of article 29 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, appointment to the post shall be made by direct recruitment:

Provided that—

- (a) 70% of the posts shall be filled up from persons who have passed the prescribed course from the Medical Assistant Training School set up by the Government and also served the internship period specified therefor; and
- (b) 30% of the posts shall be filled up from amongst National Medical Practitioners.

(2) No person shall be appointed to the post if, in the case of a National Medical Practitioner, he is not above 45 years of age and, in the case of others, he is not above 25 years of age.

4. **Appointment.**—(1) No appointment to the post shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Bangladesh Public Service Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Bangladesh:

Provided that this clause shall not apply in the case of a person who is already in the service of the Republic;

- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh;

(3) No appointment to the post shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by an authorised Medical Officer to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to the post unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the post; and
- (b) in the case of a person already in Government service or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

5. **Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to the post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is

not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period, terminate his service.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority—

(a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and

(b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may terminate his service.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in the post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, prescribe by order.

No. S.R.O. 222-L/81/Rash(Perso)/Proti-81-1815.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of The President's Pension Ordinance, 1979 (XVIII of 1979), the Government is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called The Former President's Secretarial Staff and Office Expenses Rules, 1981.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 29th March, 1979.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

(a) "former President" means a person who is entitled to pension under the Ordinance;

(ii) "Ordinance" means The President's Pension Ordinance, 1979 (XVIII of 1979);

(c) "section" means a section of the Ordinance; and

(d) "secretarial staff" means a stenographer or steno-typist or a clerk and includes a peon or messenger or bearer.

3. **Appointment of secretarial staff.**—(1) A former President may appoint such secretarial staff as he considers necessary in order to enable him to incur the expenses he is entitled to under section 3.

(2) The terms and conditions of service of the secretarial staff appointed under sub-rule (1) shall be such as may be determined by the former President concerned and such staff shall hold his appointment during his pleasure :

Provided that the total monthly expenditure on account of secretarial staff shall not exceed eighty per cent of one twelfth of the amount specified in clause (e) of section 3.

4. **Office expenses.**—A former President may incur twenty per cent of one twelfth of the amount specified in clause (a) of section 3 per month for stationery articles, postage charge and for other miscellaneous expenditure.

5. **Submission of bill.**—(1) A former President may claim the monthly salary of the secretarial staff by submission of bill in triplicate to the Military Secretary to the President.

(2) The expenditure incurred on account of office expenses as referred to in rule 4 may be re-imbursed also by submission of monthly bills in triplicate to the Military Secretary to the President.
