No. S.R.O. 222-L/84/MF/IRD-P/22/79/203.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 74 of the Stamp Act, 1899 (II of 1899), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in the rules regulating the supply and sale of stamps and stamp papers issued by the erstwhile Government of Bengal Notification No. 6442-S.R., dated the 2nd December, 1899 published in section II of part II of the Stamp Manual, Volume I, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,-

- (1) in rule 3,-
 - (a) in sub-rule (i), for the words "such stamps as are indicated in their licences" the words and figures "stamps up to the denomination of Taka 300" shall be substituted; and
 - (b) in sub-rule (ii), for the words "Taka one hundred each" the words "Taka three hundred each" shall be substituted;
- (2) in rule 5,-
 - (a) in sub-rule (i), for the word and figure "Rs. 100" the word and figure "Taka 300" shall be substituted; and
 - (b) in sub-rule (ii), for the figure "100" the figure "300" shall be substituted; and

(3) in rules 6 and 6A, for the word and figure "Rs. 100", wherever occurring, the word and figure "Taka 300" shall be substituted.
