ORDER

Dhaka, the 3rd June, 1984

No. S.R.O. 224-L/84/840/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of section 21 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to make the following further amendments in its Order No. S.R.O. 213-L/83/786/Cus., dated the 30th June, 1983, namely:—

In the aforesaid Order,—

(A) in Annex I,—

(a) in sub-head A, after serial number 813, the following shall be added, namely:—

- “814. Thiophanate
- 815. Benzoyl Chloride
- 816. Cinnamic Aldehyde

- (ii) in Serial No. 10, *after* the words "Poly Aluminium paper", the oblique and words "/Aluminium or Polythene Pouches (Sachet)" shall be *inserted*;
- (iii) *after* Serial No. 10, the following shall be *added*, namely:—
 "11. Neutral Glass Ampoules
 12. Special Bottles for Eye/Ear Drops with fitments.";
- (B) in Annex II,—

- (i) in Serial No. 425, *after* the word and number "Polysorbate 80", the oblique, word and number "/Tween 20" shall be *added*;
