এস, আর, ও নং-২৪৬-আইন/৯৭ (বিধি-৬/৯৭)—Police Act, 1861 (V of 1861) এর section 2 তে প্রদত্ত ক্ষমতাবলে সরকার Police Regulations Bengal, 1943 Volume 1 এর নিম্নরূপ অধিকতর সংশোধন করিল, যথাঃ—

উপরি-উক্ত Regulations এর—

(1) regulation 739 এর clause (b) এর sub-clause (ii) এর পরিবর্তে নিম্নরূপ sub-clause (ii) প্রতিস্থাপিত হইবে, যথাঃ—

“(ii) One or more Selection Boards, each consisting of one Police Officer not below the rank of Deputy Inspector-General of Police, two Police Officers not below the rank of Superintendent of Police nominated by the Inspector-General of Police and two such other Persons as nominated by the Government, shall arrange to take physical measurement, physical test which will include running for 137.16 Metres and jumping and rope climbing, written examination and psychological test of the candidates on a date or dates to be mentioned in the advertisement.”;

(2) regulation 741 এর, “1-Unarmed Police” শিরোনামাধীন, clause (c) এর—

(ক) sub-clause (v) এর পরিবর্তে নিম্নরূপ sub-clause (v) প্রতিস্থাপিত হইবে, যথাঃ—

“(v) List of candidates, who will secure 50% marks (Pass Marks) or above in each subject, showing marks secured by them shall be sent by the respective Deputy Inspector-General of Police of the Ranges to the Police Headquarters. Inspector-General of Police will then arrange a viva voce test of such candidates by constituting one or more Selection Boards. The total marks of the viva voce test will be 50 and the pass marks will be 25”;

(খ) sub-clause (vi) এর পরিবর্তে নিম্নরূপ sub-clause (vi) প্রতিস্থাপিত হইবে, যথাঃ—

“(vi) Each Selection Board Constituted Under sub-clause (v) will consist of one Police Officer not below the rank of Deputy Inspector-General of Police, two Police Officers not below the rank of Superintendent of Police nominated by the Inspector-General of Police and two such other Persons as nominated by the Government. The Selection Board shall prepare a district wise panel of the selected candidates. The number of candidates selected from each district and their names shall be placed in the list in order of merit. The Selection Board shall send the list of the selected candidates to the Inspector-General of Police. Inspector-General of Police will send the list of the selected candidates to the respective Deputy Inspector-General of Police of the Ranges. The Deputy Inspector-General of Police of the concerned Range shall cause verification of character and antecedents of the selected candidates through the Superintendents of Police of the respective districts.”
