Whereas it appears to me that accused No. 1, Nail No. 1212/3674 Tarani Kanta Roy, son of Janta Ram Roy of village Narayanpur, P.S. Parbatipur, district Dinajpur, is wanted in connection with Mohadebpur P.S. Case No. 1, dated 2nd September, 1972, M.L.R. Case No. 72/77 and G.R. Case No. 615/72, u/ss 148/149/380/382/302, B.P.C.;
