Martial Law Case No. 84/83.

Whereas it has been made to appear to me that the accused Hafez Abdur Rouf Sarwar Kamal, son of Mazhar Ali, Vill. Jalalabad, P.S. Sunamgonj, Dist. Syhet, is required for the purpose of trial in Summary Martial Law Court No. 28;

And whereas the court has reason to believe that the said accused Hafez Abdur Rouf Sarwar Kamal in the abovementioned case is absconding or concealing himself to avoid appearance or arrest for the said purpose;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Regulation 2(11) of the Martial Law Regulation No. 1 of 1982, this Summary Martial Law Court No. 28, do hereby direct the aforesaid accused person to appear in this Court at 09:00 hours on 30th July 1984 in Summary Martial Law Court No. 28, in Sutrapur P.S. Case No. 33(4)83, failing which he will be tried *in absentia* and his properties, both movable and immovable, may be forfeited to the Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Regulation 2(11) of the Martial Law Regulation No. 1 of 1982, this Summary Martial Law Court No. 28, do hereby direct the aforesaid accused person to appear in this court at 07:00 hours on 15th July 1984 in Summary Martial Law Court No. 28, in Kapashia P.S. Case No. 4(11)82, failing which he will be tried *in absentia* and his properties, both movable and immovable, may be forfeited to the Government:
