NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 12th October 1978.

No. S.R.O. 26*-L/78.—Whereas the Government is of opinion that lands under cultivation within the mouzas described in the Schedule below, hereinafter referred to as the Scheduled mouzas, are benefited or are likely to be benefited by irrigation water supplied or regulated by the Bangladesh Water Development Board;

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Irrigation (Imposition of Water Rate) Ordinance, 1963 (E.P. Ord. VII of 1963), the Government is pleased to declare its intention to impose water rate in the Scheduled mouzas at the rate of three per cent of the gross increased benefits accruing to the owners or occupiers of lands under cultivation within the Scheduled mouzas as a result of the supply of regulation or irrigation water to such lands.

Any person who is interested in any land likely to be affected by the imposition of the water rate may, within a period of one month from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette, prefer objections to the Government to the intended imposition of water rate, or the rate at

Dacca, the 5th October, 1978.

No. F. 7-4/76-SC (AD).—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (7) of Article 107 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the Supreme Court, with the approval of the President, is pleased to make the following amendments in the Supreme Court (Appellate Division) Rules, 1973, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules, in the FIFTH SCHEDULE, in the item 12,—

- (a) for the letters "Rs" wherever occurring the letters "Tk" shall be substituted;

- (b) for the figures "2.50" in the second column against sub-item (ii) in the first column the figures "6.50" shall be *substituted*, and
- (c) for the figures "2.00" in the second column against sub-item (v) in the first column the figures "4.50" shall be *substituted*.
