#### ORDER

# Dhaka, the 2nd July, 1986

No. S.R.O. 270-L/86/1009/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 21(b) of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and section 5A of the Sales Tax Ordinance, 1982 (XVIII of 1982), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to authorise delivery of the goods imported for generation, transmission and distribution of electric power including capital machinery by the Bangladesh Power Development Board and the Rural Electrification Board on payment of customs duty at the rate of 7.5% ad valorem and without payment of any sales tax except the following goods, namely:—

- (a) Single phase electric meter;
- (b) Transport;
- (c) Office equipments;
- (d) Consumer goods; and
- (e) Airconditioner/aircooler (domestic type).

# NOTIFICATION 2000 DAGS

#### Dhaka, the 2nd July, 1986

No. S.R.O. 271.L/86/MVRT/1A.1/85(Part-1).—The following draft of certain further amendments to the Motor Vehicle Rules, 1984 which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 50 of the Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1983 (LV of 1983), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 173 of the said Ordinance for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration on or after 23rd July, 1986.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft before the date specified will be considered by the Government.

In the aforesaid Rules, for rule 72 the following shall be substituted, namely :-

- "72. Exemption from certificate of fitness.-The certificate of fitness referred to in section 47 shall not apply to-
  - (a) a two wheeled motor cycle other than that used for hire or reward;
  - (b) any motor vehicle constructed or adapted or used for carrying for not more than eight persons including the driver, not being a transport vehicle, for the first five years of its manufacture.

Explanation.—The date of manufacture of a vehicle shall be counted from the 1st day of January of the respective year".
