No. S.R.O. 299-L/78/Admin/1/D-1/78.— In exercise of the powers conferred by section 176 of the Army Act, 1952 (XXXIX of 1952), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Army Act Rules, 1954, namely:

In the aforesaid Rules, in rule 17, in the annexed Table,—

(a) under the heading "IV.— CONFINEMENT TO THE LINES",—

(i) in entry (d) in column 1, for the full-stop at the end a semi-colon shall be substituted; and

(ii) after entry (d) in column 1 amended as aforesaid and the entries relating thereto in columns 2, 3 and 4, the following new entry shall be added, namely:—

No. S.R.O. 300-L/78/FP/S-3/3/77/362.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following amendments in the Directorate of Population Control and Family Planning (Strengthening of Maternity and Child Health Services) Gazetted Class I Officers Recruitment Rules, 1977, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules—

(a) for rule 5 the following shall be substituted, namely:—

"5. Appointment by promotion or absorption.—(1) Appointment by promotion or absorption to a specified post shall be made after considering the recommendations of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may set up for the purpose and after consultation with the Commission.

(2) All promotion or absorption cases in respect of posts specified at Sl. No. 1 and 2 of the Schedule shall be considered on the basis of merit-cum-seniority and, in respect of the other posts, on the basis of seniority-cum-merit.

(3) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has unsatisfactory service records;" and

(b) in the Schedule, for the entries in column 3 against serial number 1 in column 1 the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“Not below 32 years, relaxable by 5 years in the case of Government servant”.

Dewan, Controller-General of Prices and Supplies, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, hereby fix the maximum retail selling price of medicine produced by M/s. Organon (Bangladesh) Ltd. 18/20, Motijheel Commercial Area, Dacca as under:—
