R. O. 202-L/81/40-Excise, dated the 6th June 1981, namely:—

In the aforesaid Notification, in Table I, against item No. 10.02 in the first column, for the entry (k) in column 2 and the entries relating thereto in column 3 the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“(k) Metal containers
up to 1 litre capacity
used for re-packing of
Basudin 60 EC—an
agricultural pesticide.
