NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 16th September, 1981

No. S.R.O. 318-L/81/379-Poll(I).—WHEREAS the Government is of the opinion that it is expedient for the public safety to prohibit absolutely the manufacture, possession and importation of explosives within the limits of the whole of Bangladesh;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Explosives Act, 1884 (IV of 1884), the Government is pleased to prohibit absolutely the manufacture, possession and importation of explosives within the limits of the whole of Bangladesh, except Madaripur and Shariatpur Subdivisions of Faridpur district and Sadar North Subdivision of Bakerganj district and the whole of Khulna district the manufacture, possession and importation of explosives within the limits of which have already been prohibited absolutely by Notification No. S.R.O. 24-L/81/23-Poll(I), dated the 21st January 1981, and Notification No. S.R.O. 268-L/81/346 Poll(I), dated the 20th August 1981 respectively.

2. This notification shall remain in force for a period of three months commencing on the date of its publication in the official Gazette.
