NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 4th December, 1979.

No. S.R.O. 333-L/79.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE GAZETTED OFFICERS (REGISTRATION DEPARTMENT)  
RECRUITMENT RULES, 1979.

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Gazetted Officers (Registration Department) Recruitment Rules, 1979.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) "appointing authority" means, in relation to the post of Sub-Registrar, the Inspector General of Registration, and in relation to other specified posts, the Government;
- (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) "Probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post against a substantive vacancy;
- (d) "recognised University" means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other University declared by the Government, after consultation with the Commission, to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) "requisite qualification", in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (f) "Schedule" means a Schedule annexed to these rules;
- (g) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule I;
- (h) "Syllabus" means the Syllabus for the post of Sub-Registrar set out in the Schedule II.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule I appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment;
- (b) by promotion; or
- (c) by transfer on deputation.



(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit if any, laid down in Schedule I for that post:

Provided that the upper age limit in the case of female candidates, Freedom Fighters and the candidates who are already in the service of the Republic may be relaxed by the Government by such period as it may determine from time to time.

4. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment unless he qualifies himself in a written competitive examination and *viva voce* test to be conducted by the Commission on the subjects the syllabi of which have been laid down in Schedule II.

(3) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of Bangladesh;
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(4) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

5. **Appointment by promotion.**—Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of such Departmental Promotion Committee as may be constituted in this behalf:

Provided that appointment by promotion to a specified post of higher class shall be made on the recommendation of the Commission.

6. **Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation,—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and
- (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Soon after the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (3), confirm him; and
  - (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during the period of probation was not satisfactory, may—
    - (i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service, and
    - (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.
- (3) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as may be prescribed by Government from time to time.

Subject to the provisions of the proviso to sub-rule (2) of rule 3, maximum age limit shall be 28 years on the 1st day of October of the year previous to which the examination under sub-rule (2) of rule 4 is held.

(i) 95% by direct recruitment ...

(ii) 5% by promotion from amongst the Head Assistants and Upper Division Assistants of the Registration Directorate and Head Clerks of the District Registration Offices.

(i) For Direct recruitment:

Must have at least a Bachelor's degree from a recognised University.

(ii) For promotion:

At least 5 years' experience as Head Assistant or Head Clerk in the Registration Directorate or District Registration Offices or, at least 5 years' experience as Upper Division Assistant in the Registration Directorate.
