ORDER

Dhaka, the 20th July, 1985

No. S.R.O. 338-L/85.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Government is pleased to make the following Order, namely :—

IMPORT POLICY ORDER, 1985-86

1. **Short title and duration.**—(1) This Order may be called the Import Policy (July—June) Order, 1985-86.

(2) It shall remain in force until the 30th day of June, 1986.

2. **Definitions.**—In this Order, unless there is anything repugnant to the subject or context,—

(i) "Act" means the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950) ;

(ii) "Annex" means an Annex appended to this Order ;

(iii) "basis of licensing" means percentage, rate or formula adopted for determining the share of an importer ;

(iv) "commercial importer" means an importer registered under the Importers, Exporters and Indentors (Registration) Order, 1981, who imports goods for sale without further processing, but does not include importers registered under the Wages Earners' Scheme (WES) ;

- (v) "entitlement" means yearly requirement of raw materials, packing materials and spares of an industrial consumer as recommended by the Sponsoring Authority and as recorded in the Pass Book ;
- (vi) "I.T.C. Schedule" means the Import Trade Control Schedule published under No. S.R.O. 322-L/85, dated 4th July, 1985 ;
- (vii) "importer under the Wages Earners' Scheme" means an importer registered under the Importers, Exporters and Indentors (Registration) Order, 1981 for import only under the Wages Earners' Scheme ;
- (viii) "L/C" means a letter of credit opened for the purpose of import under this Order ;
- (ix) "L/C Authorisation Form" means the form prescribed for the authorisation of the opening of L/C without obtaining import licence ;
- (x) "Negative List" means the list of items the import of which is banned ;
- (xi) "Pass Book" means a book which,—
 - (a) when issued to an industrial consumer, gives the items of import as raw and packing materials and spare parts, the value of entitlement and ITC classification ;
 - (b) when issued to a commercial importer, gives the category (a) held by him with ITC classification ;
 - (c) when issued to an importer under the Wages Earners' Scheme, indicates his eligibility for operation as an importer under that Scheme ;
 - (d) when issued to an indenter, shows the name (s) and address (es) of the foreign principal (s) whom he represents and the item (s) for which he holds agency or sole agency ;
- (xii) "permit" means authorisation without involving foreign exchange issued by the licensing authority and includes import permit, clearance permit or export permit, as the case may be ;
- (xiii) "public sector importers" mean importers being Government organisations, statutory bodies, corporations and universities, research institutions, and industrial enterprises in the public sector ;
- (xiv) "Restricted List" means the list of items the import of which is subject to such restrictions as may be specified therein ;
- (xv) "Wages Earners' Scheme (WES)" means a Scheme under which the foreign exchange required for import of goods under this Order is met out of the remittances made by Bangladeshi nationals earning wages abroad ; and
- (xvi) all other terms in this Order shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Act and in the Orders issued thereunder.

3. Regulation of Import.—Import of goods under this Order shall be regulated as under:—

- (1) *Negative List*: Items included in this list (Annex-I) shall not be permissible for import.

- (ii) *Restricted List* : An item included in this list (Annex-II) shall be importable only on fulfilment of the conditions specified therein against the item.
- (iii) *Freely Importable items* : Unless otherwise specified, an item the name of which does not occur in either the Negative list or in the Restricted List shall be freely importable. Import of items at official exchange rate shall, however, be subject to specific allocations notified by the Chief Controller from time to time.
- (iv) All imports into Bangladesh shall be subject to such general or specific conditions as may be prescribed in this Order.

4. Source of finance.—Import may be allowed against—

- (i) cash ;
- (ii) external economic aid (commodity aid, loan, credit and grant);
- (iii) commodity exchange :
 - (a) barter ;
 - (b) special trading arrangement (STA) ;
- (iv) foreign exchange earnings of the Bangladesh nationals abroad under Wages Earners' Scheme (WES).

5. Abolition of the Export Performance Licensing (XPL) and Import Entitlement Certificate (IEC) system.—The four-slab XPL/IEC system is abolished and replaced by the three-slab XPB (Export Performance Benefit) system. The exporters under this system will receive their XPB at a rate calculated by adding to the official rate of exchange a premium represented by the proportionate difference between the secondary and the official exchange rates as indicated by the percentages of the respective slabs directly from the Banks at the time of negotiating their export documents. No IEC shall henceforth be issued.

6. Fund provision for financing import.—

- (i) Subject to availability of funds, efforts will be made to provide funds, as far as practicable, from one specified source for financing the entire import requirement of any particular commercial item or of raw and packing materials and spare parts for any particular sector of industry.
- (ii) A portion of the resources at official exchange rate shall be specifically kept reserved for such imports as may help acquisition of knowledge and technology and improve the prospect of exports.
- (iii) Unless otherwise specified, the import authorisations at official exchange rate shall be notified separately for the first half and the second half of 1985-86 financial year. Such authorisations shall be subject to the basis of licensing, source of financing and such other terms and conditions as may be notified by the Chief Controller from time to time.

7. ITC Schedule Number.—A new Import Trade Control Order with revised ITC numbers replacing the Import Trade Control Order, 1979 along with the ITC Schedule annexed thereto has been issued and made effective from the 1st July, 1985 (*vide* No. S.R.O. 322-L/85, dated 4-7-1985). For

import purposes in future, use of classification number as given in the new ITC Schedule shall be compulsory. No bank shall process any LCA Form or open any L/C for import of any item(s) without properly recording the corresponding ITC number(s) on the LCA Form/L.C.

8. Special provision for import by highly qualified scientists, doctors and engineers.—A highly qualified Bangladeshi scientist, doctor or engineer who lived abroad for at least three years before returning to Bangladesh for permanent residence will be allowed to import professional and scientific equipment of C&F value upto Tk. 5.00 (Five) lac out of his own foreign exchange earnings abroad without import control restrictions.

9. Special facilities for import at official exchange rate for the export oriented industrial units and for research and publication.—

- (i) **Import of Technology by export oriented industries.**—To help the entrepreneurs initiate technological improvements wherever necessary, import of technology at the official exchange rate will be allowed, under procedure to be notified, in the following cases :
- import by industrial units with export potential of machinery that will bring about significant economies in raw material consumption, reduce production cost, diversify products, improve quality and quantity of the output or reduce energy consumption or conserve energy;
 - import of technical know-how and acquisition of foreign consultancy service by an industrial undertaking with export potential which will result in technological improvement;
 - import of drawing and design by export oriented garment industrial undertakings;
 - import by trading houses with export performances of technical designs, drawings and other documentations in their own favour for supply to their supporting manufacturers.
- (ii) **Import for the purposes of Research and Publication.**—
- Scientific and Research Laboratories may import their requirement of equipment and know-how at official exchange rate within value-ceiling to be notified, without import licence or permit or prior permission.
 - Established publishers and public sector agencies, such as, Bangla Academy, Islamic Foundation, Central Library, Dhaka Museum and Universities may import at official exchange rate reprint rights of books on outright purchase basis within value-ceiling to be notified without import licence or permit or prior permission.
- (iii) **Import of machinery and spare parts for BMRE.**—Import of machinery and spare parts for balancing, modernisation, replacement and expansion (BMRE) purpose by any recognised industry with export potential shall be allowed at the official exchange rate in terms of procedure to be notified.
- (iv) **Facilities for counter trade.**—Industries which can ensure export of part of the finished products through the supplier of raw materials either in payment of the raw material cost or otherwise, will be allowed, under procedure to be notified, foreign exchange at official exchange rate for import of such raw materials

- (v) **Import of special types of raw materials for export industries.**—To encourage production and export of specialised and delicate objects, where often a variety of inputs are required, sometimes of foreign origin, foreign exchange at official rate will be made available for import of special types of raw materials and also special types of tools and equipment, if any, needed for such purposes. Import will be allowed, by concerned export oriented industries or craftsmen involved in the production of such goods or, under bonded warehouse system, by TCB on receipt of orders from the concerned export oriented industries or craftsmen.

10. Import by Public Sector Agencies.—No Objection Certificate (NOC) or Right Of Refusal (ROR) from any authority will not be required for import of any item by any public sector agency if the name of such item does not occur in either the Negative List or the Restricted List. Ministry of Commerce, on application from such a public sector agency, may, however, under special circumstances, permit the import of a banned or otherwise restricted item subject to ROR issued by the Ministry of Industries or NOC issued by the sponsoring Ministry or Division, as the case may be.

11. Conditions of ban or restriction.—If the import of an item, or the commercial import of the raw materials for the production of an item, has been banned at any time before the coming into effect of this Order or if such ban has been made effective by virtue of the placement of the item in the Negative List or Restricted List, as the case may be, annexed to this Order, such ban shall be subject to the following conditions:—

- (a) The concerned sponsoring authority will strictly monitor production by the industrial units in the sector which is being afforded protection by the ban and will recommend withdrawal of ban if the sector fails to respond to the protection. The ban may be revoked if the quality of products deteriorates or if production level falls leaving unutilised capacity. Such of the protected units as are now primarily engaged in assembly type activities shall actively and expeditiously move towards progressive manufacture.
- (b) The sponsoring authority concerned, Tariff Commission and the Director General, Prices and Market Intelligence will continuously monitor the prices of the items covered by such ban to guard against undue increase of price. If the price of any item is increased except for factors like rise in the price of raw materials or increase in the rate of exchange or if the increase in the price of the item is disproportionately high compared to the rise in the prices of the raw materials, the ban may be revoked.

12. Amendment or alteration of this Order.—The Government in the Ministry of Commerce may at any time amend or alter the provisions of this Order including the Negative and the Restricted Lists.

13. Import in contravention of the Act.—Goods imported in violation of any provision of this Order or of any notification issued thereunder by the Chief Controller shall be treated to have been imported in contravention of the provisions of the Act.

14. General Conditions Qualifying Import of Goods:

- (i) **Restrictions on import of certain types of goods.**—Following goods shall not be importable:—
- (a) maps, charts and geographical globes which indicate the territory of Bangladesh but do not do so in accordance with the maps published by the Department of Survey, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh;
 - (b) horror comics, obscene and subversive literature including such pamphlets, posters, photographs, films, gramophone records and cassette tapes;
 - (c) documents and papers containing matters likely to outrage the religious feelings and beliefs of any class of the citizens of Bangladesh;
 - (d) old, second-hand and reconditioned goods except items specifically mentioned in this Order;
 - (e) factory rejects and goods of job lot, stock lot or substandard quality;
 - (f) goods (including their containers) bearing any words or inscriptions of a religious connotation, the use or disposal of which may injure the religious feelings and beliefs of any class of the citizens of Bangladesh; and
 - (g) goods (including their containers) bearing any obscene picture, writing, inscription or visible representation.
- (ii) **Restrictions regarding Source of Procurement of Goods.**—Goods from South Africa and Israel or goods originating from these two countries shall not be importable. Import of goods shall also not be permissible on the flag vessels of Taiwan, South Africa and Israel.
- (iii) **Import at Competitive Rate.**—Import shall be made at the most competitive rate and the importers may be required, at any time, to submit documents regarding the price paid or to be paid by them.
- (iv) **Pre-shipment Inspection.**—Unless otherwise specified, pre-shipment inspection of imported goods shall not be obligatory in case of import by the private sector importers.
- (v) **Import on C&F Basis.**—All import by sea, air and land route shall be made on cost and freight (C&F) basis. Import on free on board (FOB) basis may be made with the clearance of the Bangladesh Bank.
- (vi) **Shipment on Bangladesh Flag Vessels.**—Subject to waivers specified below, shipment of goods will normally be made on Bangladesh flag vessels. Import of goods up to 20 (twenty) metric tons or Tk. 10.00 (ten) lac

whichever is less, in case of single/individual consignee, and up to 100 (one hundred) metric tons or Tk. 50·00 (fifty) lac, whichever is less, in case of group import, may be made in non-Bangladesh flag vessels. The Director General of Shipping may notify general waivers in certain cases, such as, (a) shipment of goods from foreign ports which are not visited by Bangladesh vessels, and (b) import of goods on the basis of specific agreements which provide condition of C&F contract. In all other cases, a certificate of waiver shall be obtained from the Director General of Shipping for importation of goods in non-Bangladesh flag vessel. If there appears to be no possibility of a Bangladesh flag vessel visiting a port within next one month, waiver will be given within 72 hours of application for waiver.

15. Import Authorisation.—

- (i) **Import licence not required.**—No import licence will be necessary for import of any item.
- (ii) **Import against LCA Form.**—Unless otherwise specified, imports, irrespective of the source of finance, shall be allowed only through submission of LCA Form, duly filled in, to the concerned nominated bank.
- (iii) **Import against L/C.**—Unless otherwise specified, import shall be made only by opening irrevocable letter of credit (L/C).
- (iv) **Import against LCA Form but without opening of Letter of Credit (L/C).**—Import against LCA Form may be allowed without opening of Letters of Credit in the following cases:—
 - (a) books, journals, magazines and periodicals on sight draft or usance bill basis ;
 - (b) drugs and medicines (allopathic) by a commercial importer of the item for total value not exceeding Tk. 2,000 (Taka two thousand) only at the official exchange rate on sight draft within the overall value of the L/C Authorisation(s) for the year 1985-86 ;
 - (c) import of any permissible item for an amount not exceeding US \$ 1,500 (US Dollar one thousand five hundred) only during 1985-86 against remittance made from Bangladesh under WES.
- (v) **Import against Import Permit and Clearance Permit.**—In the following cases neither LCA Form nor opening of L/C will be necessary, but import permit or clearance permit will have to be obtained by the importer, for :—
 - (a) import of books, magazines, journals, periodicals and scientific and laboratory equipment against surrender of UNESCO Coupons ;

- (b) import of complete plant and machinery under 'Direct Payment Abroad Basis' by Bangladeshi wages earners living abroad, subject to condition specified at paragraph 17 (xiii) of this Order ;
 - (c) import of items by passengers coming from abroad in excess of the permissible limits as per the Passenger's Baggage Rules, provided the import of the item is permissible under the relevant baggage rules ;
 - (d) import of free samples and advertising materials above the prescribed ceiling as per paragraph 17 (xvi) of this Order and unsolicited gift parcel on freight pre-paid basis of value in excess of Tk. 2,000 ;
 - (e) import under Direct Payment Abroad, Pay-As-You-Earn-Scheme and Product Bonus System ;
 - (f) any other goods not specifically exempted.
- (vi) Time limit for opening of L/C.—
- (a) Unless otherwise specified, in sub-paragraphs (iv) and (v) above, imports irrespective of the source of finance, shall be allowed only through submission of LCA Form followed by the opening of an irrevocable letter of credit. For import at the official exchange rate, letter of credit shall be opened by all importers within 90 (ninety) days from the date of issuance of the allocation letter or Public Notice indicating or announcing the share or basis of licensing and source of financing.
 - (b) The time limit of 90 (ninety) days for opening L/C may be extended by a maximum of 30 (thirty) days by the Chief Controller in cases where—
 - (1) the original Letter of Credit had been established within the prescribed time limit, but the supplier had refused to supply the goods and returned the Letter of Credit ;
 - (2) the original Letter of Credit had been opened strictly in terms of the indent or proforma invoice ; and
 - (3) the application for such extension is made within the period of validity of the original Letter of Credit.
 - (c) If a commercial importer or an industrial consumer/sector, who/which has been allocated funds from any source at the official exchange rate, fails to open L/C within the aforesaid time limit, the allocation may be withdrawn, diverted and reallocated to other importers/sectors according to need.
- (vii) Validity of LCA for shipment.—
- (a) Unless otherwise specified, shipment of goods shall take place within 17 (seventeen) months in the case of machinery and spare parts and 11(eleven) months in the case of all other items, from the date of issuance of LCA Form by Bank or registration of L/C Authorisation Form with Bangladesh Bank Registration Unit, as the case may be.

- (b) Validity of LCA issued against cash shall not be extended except where shipment cannot be made within the validity of LCA due to circumstances beyond the control of the importer. In such cases, validity may be extended by the licensing authority for the minimum period considered necessary :

Provided that—

- (1) the application for grant of such extension is received within 7 (seven) days of the expiry of the L/C Authorisation;
- (2) L/C was opened at a lower price compared to the prevailing international price at the time of revalidation; and
- (3) the supplier was agreeable to supply the goods at the original price at which L/C was opened.

No revalidation shall, however, be allowed if the item concerned is no longer importable.

- (viii) **Restriction on L/C after imposition of ban/restriction.**—No extension of the date of shipment in any Letter of Credit or amendment of Letter of Credit or enhancement of the value or quantity of goods shall be allowed by the nominated bank or by the licensing authority after the import of the item or items has been banned or restricted.

(ix) Submission of L/C Authorisation Form.—

- (1) Unless otherwise notified, L/C Authorisation Form for import at the official exchange rate by both the commercial importers and the industrial consumers shall be submitted for the first half and the second half of 1985-86 policy period separately in accordance with the basis of licensing to be notified by the Chief Controller. Separate L/C Authorisation Form shall be submitted by the industrial consumers for raw and packing materials and for spare parts irrespective of the source of finance.
 - (2) The total value of L/C Authorisation at official exchange rate issued to an importer shall, in no case, exceed his due share as notified by the licensing authority.
 - (3) While determining the due share of an importer, adjustment will be made against advance or excess or additional share already utilised or against revalidation of past licence; and LCA Form shall be issued for the balance share only.
- (x) **Documents required to be submitted alongwith LCA Form.**—Importers in both public sector and private sector shall be required to submit

to their nominated banks the following documents alongwith the L/C Authorisation Form for opening Letter of Credit :—

- (a) L/C Application Form duly signed by the importer;
 - (b) indents for goods issued by an indentor or a proforma invoice, as the case may be; and
 - (c) insurance cover note.
- (xi) **Additional documents to be furnished by public sector importers.**—In addition to the documents mentioned in sub-paragraph (x) above public sector importers shall submit the following documents :—
- (a) attested photocopy of allocation letter issued by the allocating authority in favour of the concerned public sector agency (specifying the source, amount, purpose, validity and other terms and conditions);
 - (b) attested photocopy of sub-allocation letter, if any, issued in favour of the importing unit or agency;
 - (c) attested photocopy of sanction letter from the administrative Ministry or Division or authority, wherever required; and
 - (d) a declaration by the authorised officer of the concerned importing agency under proper seal and signature, indicating the amount already utilised and the amount which remained unutilised out of the amount of any particular allocation made by the Government or competent authority and certifying that raw materials imported or to be imported has not been or shall not be, sold or otherwise disposed of in unprocessed form.
- (xii) **Additional documents to be furnished by private sector importers.**—In addition to the documents mentioned in sub-paragraph (x) above, private sector importers will be required to submit the following documents :—
- (a) valid membership certificate from a recognised Chamber of Commerce and Industry or Town Association or Trade Association listed in Annex-IV;
 - (b) proof of payment of renewal fees for the Import Registration Certificate for 1985-86;
 - (c) a declaration, in triplicate, that the importer has paid income-tax or submitted income-tax return for the preceding year; and
 - (d) any such documents as may be required as per this Order or a public notice, or instructions issued by Chief Controller, from time to time, under this Order.
- (xiii) **Violation of the requirement of LCA/LC.**—Shipment effected before authentication of the L/C Authorisation Form by the nominated bank and registration with the Bangladesh Bank, wherever necessary, and before opening of L/C or after the expiry of the validity of the L/C

Authorisation Form or L/C shall be treated as import in contravention of this Order. L/C Authorisation Form obtained on the basis of false or incorrect particulars or by adopting any fraudulent means shall be treated as invalid and void *ab initio*.

(xiv) **Import against Indent and Proforma Invoice.—**

- (a) except in the cases specified at sub-paragraph (b), L/C shall be opened only against an indent issued by a registered indenter ;
- (b) import against foreign suppliers' pro forma invoice may be allowed in the following cases only, provided it is confirmed in writing by such a supplier that he does not have an agent in Bangladesh and that the price quoted on the invoice does not include any commission for anybody :—
 - (1) import of machinery and spare parts for the existing industrial enterprises including those in the free sector ;
 - (2) import by the foreign multi-national companies operating in Bangladesh of such proprietary items (both raw materials and spare parts) as are manufactured by their parent companies. For this purpose the importer will furnish a declaration as per Annex III that the items to be imported are proprietary items manufactured by their parent company. This facility shall not, however, be applicable in case of import for BMRE purposes by such multi-national companies ;
 - (3) import of proprietary items (both raw materials and spare parts) from a foreign firm by a Bangladeshi industrial enterprise or assembling unit, if such enterprise or unit was earlier established as a joint venture or in technical collaboration with such foreign firm or where supply of such proprietary items was stipulated under an agreement with such foreign firm, which is still in force ;
 - (4) import of raw and packing materials against back-to-back L/C by export oriented industrial units operating under the bonded warehouse system ; and
 - (5) import of books, journals and periodicals.

16. **Procedure to be followed by Banks.—**

(i) **Acceptance of LCA Form by the nominated bank.—**

- (a) The nominated bank shall not accept any L/C Authorisation Form unless it is found in order, and complete in all respects. L/C Authorisation Form from a private sector industrial unit shall not be acceptable unless accompanied by a Pass Book issued by the concerned licensing authority. An industrial unit which has been issued Pass Book for import of goods exclusively under WES shall not be eligible to submit L/C Authorisation Form for import at the official exchange rate.

- (b) L/C for import of capital machinery and initial spares for setting up new industrial unit may, however, be opened without any Import Registration Certificate (IRC) or Pass Book after obtaining exemption certificate from the Chief Controller. While no formal sanction shall be necessary from the sponsoring authority for such import under WES against own finance in respect of industrial units in free sector, formal sanction and recommendation from the concerned sponsoring authority or financing institution or bank shall be necessary for setting up new unit outside free sector or against loan sanctioned by the financing institution.
- (ii) **Compulsory recording of ITC Number.**—Bank shall not process any LCA Form or L/C without properly recording the appropriate ITC number on the LCA Form or L/C. Bangladesh Bank will monitor the compliance by the banks of the above requirement.
- (iii) **Registration of L/C Authorisation Form and opening of L/C.**—In case of import under cash, International Development Agency (IDA) Credit, Overseas Economic Cooperation Fund (OECF) Loan and other source for which registration with Bangladesh Bank is necessary, the nominated bank shall forward the L/C Authorisation Form in quintuplicate to the concerned Registration Unit of Bangladesh Bank for registration of the L/C Authorisation Form. The Bangladesh Bank Registration Unit shall, after registration, return the first and second copies of the L/C Authorisation Form to the nominated Bank concerned and the third and the fourth copies thereof to the concerned licensing authority for record.
- (iv) **Cases where LCA Form at the official exchange rate are not required to be registered.**—In case of Import under loan, credit, grant or barter or STA where registration with the Bangladesh Bank is not necessary, the nominated bank, after endorsing the particulars mentioned in the L/C Authorisation Form on importer's Pass Book, shall forward the L/C Authorisation Form along with L/C Application Form and other required documents to the designated bank with the request to open L/C. The designated bank shall then open L/C and will immediately forward the third and the fourth copies of L/C Authorisation Form to the concerned licensing authority.
- (v) **LCA Form under WES.**—In case of import under WES, L/C Authorisation Form shall not be required to be registered with the Bangladesh Bank. However, the L/C opening bank shall forward the third and the fourth copies of the L/C Authorisation Form to the area licensing authority. All L/C Authorisation Forms under WES shall be prominently marked on the right hand corner at the top with rubber stamp to read as "Issued under WES".
- (vi) **Transmission of the copy of L/C for record of the Licensing Authority.**—In all cases mentioned in sub-paragraphs (iii), (iv) and (v) above, the L/C opening banks shall immediately forward a legible copy of L/C and copy of amendment thereof, if any, to the concerned licensing authority for their record.

- (vii) **Despatch of Income-Tax Declaration by private sector importer.**—The nominated bank of the concerned private sector importers shall retain one copy of the Income tax declaration furnished by the private sector importers and immediately forward the other two copies to the concerned area or regional office of the Bangladesh Bank, who in their turn, will retain one copy of the said declaration and forward the other copy to the Director (Research and Statistics), National Board of Revenue, Segunbagicha, Dhaka.

17. **Miscellaneous Provisions Regarding Import.**—

- (i) **L/C Authorisation and Permit Fee.**—There shall not be any L/C Authorisation or Permit fee for letters of credit of value upto Tk. 25,000 (Taka twenty-five thousand) only. Unless otherwise exempted under the Licence and Permit Fees Order, 1985, L/C Authorisation or Permit Fee for letter (s) of credit exceeding Tk. 25,000 (Thaka twenty-five thousand) shall be payable at a uniform rate of 2½% (two and a half per cent) *ad valorem* of the value of L/C. Such fee shall be deposited by treasury chalan under the Head of Account “42—Trade & Commerce—Fees realised under the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950”. Retirement of import documents shall not be allowed until the payment receipt in original is produced before the nominated bank.

In case of import without opening of L/C value limit for the purpose of determining the Permit Fee shall be the C&F value of the respective consignment.

- (ii) **Fee for Renewal of Registration.**—Commercial importers, industrial consumers, importers under WES, indentors and exporters shall pay the registration renewal fees at the rate specified in the Importers, Exporters and Indentors (Registration) Order, 1981. Such fees for 1985-86 shall be paid within the date notified by the Chief Controller.

Importers will pay IRC renewal fees to their respective nominated banks against appropriate receipt. The banks will, in turn, deposit the fees to Bangladesh Bank or Sonali Bank, as the case may be, and send the original copy of the deposit receipt to the area Import Control office for record and verification.

Indentors and exporters will continue to deposit their renewal fees to Bangladesh Bank or Sonali Bank, as the case may be.

- (iii) **New ITC Schedule.**—A new ITC classification schedule has been published under No. SRO 322-L/85 dated 4-7-1985. However, for convenience of importers who opened L/C on or before 31-7-1985, the old ITC number has been mentioned in the Negative and the Restricted Lists. The old numbers will become inoperative on 31-7-1985 and from 1st August, 1985 the new ITC number shall invariably be used in all L/C Authorisation Forms and letter(s) of credit.

- (iv) **ITC Committee.**—In case of any dispute between an importer and the Customs Authority on ITC classification or description of goods imported, importer may ask for adjudication by the ITC Committee set up at Chittagong, Dhaka, Chalna, Benapole and Sylhet. The respective ITC Committee will consist of representatives of the Chief Controller, Customs Authority and the local Chambers of Commerce and will be headed by the representative of the Customs Authority

If the importer is not satisfied with the decision of the local ITC Committee, he may file an appeal to the Central ITC Committee at Dhaka which shall consist of the Chief Controller as the Chairman and a Member of the National Board of Revenue and a representative of Federation of Bangladesh Chambers of Commerce and Industry as members. A revision petition may be filed with the Secretary, Ministry of Commerce in accordance with the Review, Appeal and Revision Order, 1977, if the decision in appeal does not satisfy the importer.

- (v) **Release of goods detained by the Customs.**—If a consignment of imported goods is detained by the Customs Authority, the concerned importer may apply to the Chief Controller seeking release instructions to the Customs Authority for clearance of the consignment. Such application shall be accompanied by written objection of the Customs Authority or detention memo showing the ground(s) for detention of the consignment and will be expeditiously disposed of by the Chief Controller on the basis of existing rules and regulations.
- (vi) **Pass Book for Indentors.**—All indentors, both local and foreign, engaged in indenting business in Bangladesh shall be issued with a Pass Book by the respective area licensing offices of the Chief Controller. Indentors who already held Indenting Registration Certificate shall apply in plain paper for Pass Book by 30-9-1985. The application will be accompanied by the following documents:—
- (a) Original Indenting Registration Certificate;
 - (b) Original agency agreement containing full name (s) and address (es) of the foreign supplier(s) or principal(s), full description of item(s), rate of commission payable and the validity of the agreement;
 - (c) Copy of General Index Register (GIR) Certificate;
 - (d) A Treasury Chalan showing payment of Tk. 6-00 (Taka six) only as Pass Book Fees.

If the application is correct and complete, the licensing authority shall issue the Pass Book within a fortnight.

Indentor who fails to obtain Pass Book by 31-10-1985 shall not be eligible to do indenting business and his Indenting Registration Certificate shall be liable to cancellation.

- (vii) **Transfer of Pass Book.**—Change in the nomination of bank by commercial or industrial importer may be made on the basis of no objection certificate (NOC) from his present bank. For such change prior permission from the concerned licensing authority shall not be necessary. Transferring bank shall, however, inform the concerned licensing authority in writing of such transfer of pass book. The transferring bank shall be responsible for any fraud, forgery or any other malpractice restored to in the process of transfer of Pass Book

(viii) **Compulsory Membership of recognised Chamber of Commerce and Industry/Town Association/Trade Association**

- (a) Every importer and indenter shall be a member of a Chamber of Commerce and Industry or the Bangladesh Chambers of Industries or the Town Association of the area concerned registered under the Trade Organization Ordinance, 1961 (XLV of 1961), or an Association of the Trade and Industry registered under the said Ordinance.
- (b) The registered Town Associations shall not issue any membership certificate to any importer outside the territorial jurisdiction as mentioned in their licence. Specialised Trade Associations established on all Bangladesh basis shall issue membership certificate only for the item(s) for which they have been licensed.
- (c) A list of registered Chambers of Commerce and Industry/Town Associations and Trade Associations is appended at Annex-IV to avoid confusion regarding their identity and status. Certificates from any Organisation outside this list shall not be acceptable.

(ix) **Import on Joint Basis.**—The commercial importers and industrial consumers all over the Bangladesh may form group or groups for import on joint basis according to their convenience:

Provided that the industrial consumers shall not be eligible to form any group with commercial importers and *vice-versa*. The procedure for import on joint basis is given at Annex-V.

(x) **Import by Government Servants and employees of public sector corporate bodies.**—Government servants and employees of bodies corporate set up by or under any law for the time being in force, may import without IRC permissible items for their *bona fide* personal use with prior permission from the Chief Controller. While applying for such permission, the applicants shall produce certificate from their respective heads of departments or organisations to the effect that the items to be imported are for actual use of the applicants and not for sale.

(xi) **Import by Actual Users.**—Individuals or institutions which are not registered importers may import permissible finished items except books and journals, up to C&F value of US \$ 1,000.00 (U.S. Dollar one thousand) only. Import may be made with the prior permission of the respective regional licensing authority.

(xii) **Import on Deferred Payment Basis.**—Subject to restrictions and prohibitions contained in this Order, import on deferred payment will be allowed on the basis of procedure laid down by the Bangladesh Bank in this behalf.

(xiii) **Import Against Direct Payment Abroad.**—Import against Direct payment abroad will be allowed only in the case of plant and machinery. such import shall be subject to following conditions:—

- (a) The import will be made by a Bangladeshi Wage Earner living abroad out of his own earnings outside Bangladesh;

- (b) The plant and machinery should be set up as a new industrial unit;
- (c) The plant and machinery shall be consigned either in the name of Wage Earner himself or in the name of the firm or the company of which he is a proprietor, partner or director;
- (d) If the industrial unit is in free sector, no formal sanction of any authority will be required; but if it is outside free sector, sanction will have to be obtained from competent authority;
- (e) No L/C Authorisation Form will have to be submitted and no L/C will be opened; only import permit will have to be obtained from the licensing authority.
- (xiv) **Import under Pay-As-You-Earn Scheme.**—Subject to prohibitions and restrictions, if any, contained in this Order, import under Pay-As-You-Earn-Scheme may be allowed only in the following cases:—
- (a) permissible items of plants and machinery, with the clearance of the Bangladesh Bank;
- (b) import of cargo and passenger vessels, excluding ships of steel or wooden bodies up to 1,000 DWT with the clearance of the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and IWT;
- (c) import of plant and machinery for export oriented industrial units, with the clearance of the competent sanctioning authority; and
- (d) import of vessels for sea fishing, other than trawler, with the clearance of Bangladesh Bank and Fisheries and Livestock Division.

While according sanction or approval for import under this Scheme, the sanctioning or approving authority shall endorse copies of letters of sanction or approval to the Chief Controller. The importers shall apply to the Chief Controller with the required documents for prior permission to import items under this Scheme.

- (xv) **Import under Product Bonus System.**—Only drugs and medicines (allopathic) shall be allowed to be imported under Product Bonus System during the policy period 1985-86, subject to the condition that it shall be obligatory on the part of the importers concerned to pass on the benefit to the consumers. The Director General of Prices and Market Intelligence (DGP&MI) shall devise appropriate mechanism in this behalf. Import Permit from the concerned licensing authority shall have to be obtained for import under this system, irrespective of any value limit.
- (xvi) **Import of samples and advertising materials free of charge.**—Bonafide and permissible items of advertising materials and samples may be imported free of charge without prior permission of the Chief Controller and without import permit in the following cases during 1985-86:

Advertising materials shall include, among others, brochures, posters, calendars, pamphlets and technical literature related to the trade, of the concerned importers.

Details of such imports shall be entered into the Pass Books or IRCs, as the case may be, by the Customs Authority.

Import in excess of the value-ceiling mentioned above shall be subject to prior permission of the Chief Controller and Import Permit.

(xvii) **Temporary importation for exhibitions and demonstration purposes with conditions for re-export.**—Agents and representatives of the foreign manufacturers shall be allowed to import on temporary basis machinery and equipment of their principal or parent company for arranging demonstration and exhibition in Bangladesh, subject to following conditions :

- (a) the goods brought into Bangladesh for such exhibition or demonstration will be re-exported within a period of 6 (six) months;
- (b) the importer will execute a bond and furnish a bank guarantee or an instrument to the satisfaction of the Customs Authority at the time of clearance of the goods as regards timely re-export.

(xviii) **Import into and Export from the Export Processing Zone (EPZ).**—

- (a) Imports into and exports from the Export Processing Zone (EPZ) shall remain outside the purview of this Order. The banking and customs procedures relating to export from or import into, the Export Processing Zone to or from any country outside Bangladesh shall be regulated in accordance with the instructions issued in that behalf by the Bangladesh Bank and the National Board of Revenue, respectively, from time to time;
- (b) All data regarding import into and export from the Export Processing Zone shall be maintained by the Customs Authority concerned;
- (c) All movement of goods between the Export Processing Zone and any other area in Bangladesh outside the Zone shall be regulated by the existing Imports and Exports Control Regulations.

- (xix) **Claim for Import facility in cases accepted in Review, Appeal and Revision.**—No claim for import shall be entertained in cases accepted under Review, Appeal and Revision Order, 1977, if the item is no longer permissible for import. Import Authorisation in such cases may be issued in accordance with the Import Policy Order in force.

18. Import under Barter:

- (i) **Compulsory import under barter.**—In cases where allocations have been made and basis of licensing notified for import of any item under barter as well as other sources of finance, it will be compulsory for the concerned importers to first open L/C for utilisation of the barter share. This provision which shall apply equally to both public and private sector importers, regardless of their being industrial or commercial importers, will not, however, apply to the opening of L/C for import of any item against allocation(s), if any, under tied commodity aid. If any importer, for whom barter share has been announced or notified for any item, decides to open L/C under Wages Earners' Scheme for the said item through a bank other than his nominated bank, a certificate shall have to be produced from the concerned designated bank to the L/C opening bank under Wages Earners' Scheme to the effect that L/C for the barter share as notified by the Chief Controller has already been established.
- (ii) **Incentive for commercial importer under barter.**—A commercial importer who has live item under barter source will be eligible to import an additional item under any of the following arrangements:—
- He may participate in the selection of importers for C.I. Sheet on population basis by District Committee;
 - He may participate in the selection of importers for second-hand clothing on population basis by District Committee;
 - He may opt for import of books under the procedure to be notified by the Chief Controller ;
 - He may opt for import of the item specified at serial Nos. 2 to 27 of Part B of the Restricted List (Annex-II) under Wages Earners' Scheme as per procedure given in paragraph 20 (ii).

Before opening L/C for the additional item mentioned above the importer shall first establish L/C for the barter share for his own item. No bank shall open L/C for such additional item without first satisfying itself that letter of credit for the item under barter share has been established.

19. General Principles for Industrial Import :

- (i) **Import to be limited to items recorded in the Pass Book.**—Industrial consumers shall be allowed to import only those items which are duly recorded in their Pass Book ; irrespective of the source (s) of finance. The items recorded in the Pass Book may, however, be imported in any quantity, excepting such items whose import has been subjected to any general or specific restriction. Regardless of any entry in the Pass Book, an item shall not be importable if its name occurs in the Negative List or is subjected to such restriction as may be specified in the Restricted List if its name occurs in the Restricted List.

- (ii) **Import at official exchange rate.**—Subject to availability of funds, recognised industrial units under such specific sectors as may be decided by the Government shall be allowed to import essential raw and packing materials and spare parts at the official exchange rate. The share for the first-half and for the second-half of 1985-86 financial year at the official exchange rate may be given separately. L/C Authorisation Form shall be submitted for the due share as per basis of licensing, source of finance and other terms and conditions as notified by the Chief Controller from time to time. Subject to provisions of sub-paragraphs (i) and (v), such industrial units shall, however, be allowed to import in any proportion or combinations within their overall respective share or entitlement.
- (iii) **Import under Wages Earners' Scheme (WES).**—Such industrial sectors as have not been notified for import at official exchange rate shall be required to import their requirement of raw and packing materials and spare parts under Wages Earners' Scheme, subject to provisions of sub-paragraphs (i) and (v). Industrial consumers shall be free to import under Wages Earners' Scheme only those items of raw and packing materials and spare parts which are recorded in their Pass Books up to any quantity they like, except those items whose import is subject to any general or specific restriction. While submitting L/C Authorisation Form under Wages Earners' Scheme for import of industrial raw and packing materials and spare parts, an industrial importer registered under Wages Earners' Scheme, shall furnish information as to whether he is a recognised industrial unit and whether he has been issued a Pass Book as an industrial consumer. The appropriate queries will be incorporated by the concerned bank in the Part A of the LCA Form through rubber stamp.
- (iv) **Import by ad-hoc Industrial Units.**—*Ad-hoc* industrial units in any sector of industry shall not be allowed import facility at the official exchange rate. Subject to the provisions of sub-paragraphs (i) and (v), they may, however, import the items recorded in their Pass Books under Wages Earners' Scheme provided their cases have been duly approved by the Licensing Board on the basis of the recommendation made by the sponsoring authority. Pass Book, temporary or provisional Import Registration Certificate and specific letter of authorisation shall be issued in respective cases by the concerned licensing authority in the light of the decision of the Licensing Board. No bank shall accept any L/C Authorisation Form from any *ad hoc* industrial unit unless these documents are produced to the bank by the concerned industrial unit.
- (v) **Items whose commercial import is banned.**—Commercial import of certain industrial raw materials and spare parts has been banned or restricted. Import of such items by the industrial consumers will be limited to the entitlement for such items recorded in their Pass Books.
- (vi) **Prohibition on sale/transfer/disposal of raw and packing materials and spare parts imported by industrial consumers.**—Any and all items imported by an industrial consumer shall be utilized in his unit exclusively for the purposes of production and shall not be sold, transferred or otherwise disposed of.

(vii) **Import of machinery for BMR.**—Import of machinery and spare parts for balancing, modernization and replacement (BMR) and for emergency break-down and also equipment for quality control shall be allowed only under Wages Earners' Scheme. For such imports no recommendation either from any sponsoring authority or Director of Drugs Administration (for quality control equipment) shall be necessary. Foreign industrial firms engaged in manufacture in Bangladesh and recognised by the sponsoring authority and holding valid import Registration Certificates may operate under Wages Earners' Scheme for import of machinery for balancing, modernization and replacement (BMR) and quality control equipment on recommendation from the Director General of Industries.

20. Import by Commercial Importer.

- (i) **Commercial Import at official exchange rate.**—Excepting for barter, import of as few commercial items as possible will be allowed at the official exchange rate. Import of Books during 1985-86 financial year shall, however, be allowed only at the official exchange rate. The name of items, basis of licensing, source of finance and other terms and conditions for commercial import will be notified by the Chief Controller from time to time.
- (ii) **Commercial Import under Wages Earners' Scheme (WES).**—Registered commercial importers having valid Import Registration Certificate but no live item during 1985-86 financial year will be allowed to import under Wages Earners' Scheme any one of the items mentioned at serial Nos. 2 to 27 in Part B of the Restricted List (Annex-II) at a uniform rate of Taka 25,000.00 (Taka twenty-five thousand) only per importer during 1985-86 financial year. Registered commercial importers who will otherwise have authorisation for import of any other commercial item outside this list shall not be eligible to import any of these items. These items shall also not be importable by the importers registered under Wages Earners' Scheme.

As a measure of incentive for import under barter, an exception of the above rule will, however, be made and the importers of live items under barter only shall, subject to provision of paragraph 18 be eligible for import of the items under this paragraph, but only on proof of prior establishment of L/C for their own items under barter as per basis of licensing notified by the Chief Controller.

- (iii) **Commercial import by Foreign Commercial Firms.**—Foreign commercial firms registered in Bangladesh under the Companies Act, 1913 may be allowed to import permissible items under WES, subject to prior permission from the Chief Controller on production of the following documents, namely:—
- (a) Photocopy of the valid Import Registration Certificate (Commercial);
 - (b) Photocopies of invoice, bill of lading and import permit duly certified by the bank showing the import of items under WES between July, 1983 and June, 1985 Policy periods;
 - (c) Original or photocopy of General Index Register (GIR) Certificate from Income-tax Authority indicating that they are regular Income-tax assesses;

- (d) Certified copy of the last Income-tax assessment order; and
- (e) Name and description of item(s) to be imported under WES system during the Policy period 1985-86 with quantity and approximate C & F value of each item.

21. Import by Public Sector Importers :

- (i) **Import by Ministries, Departments and other Public Sector Agencies.**—Ministries and Government departments may import goods against allocations given to them by the Ministry of Finance. No Import Licence, L/C Authorisation Form or permit shall be required for such import. The Ministries and Government departments may import their required items themselves or through the Director of Supply and Inspection.
- (ii) **Import against specific allocation of funds.**—All public sector agencies including public sector corporations, universities, research institutes and industrial enterprises shall be allowed to import permissible items on the basis of specific allocation of funds made by the Government to them for import at the official exchange rate. All such importers shall be eligible to open letter of credit directly through their nominated banks for import of permissible items on submission of L/C Authorisation Forms on the basis of allocation or sub-allocation of funds without cover of any import licence.
- (iii) **Import at official exchange rate by industrial enterprise/agency.**—Foreign exchange allocation at official exchange rate will be made to the public sector industrial enterprises or agencies to meet their requirements in the proportion in which availability of funds may justify. Such public sector importers will be free to import their agreed items (with the Ministry of Commerce) in any proportion or combination within the overall allocation made to them subject to conditions, if any, for any particular resource use. They shall not, however, sell or otherwise dispose of any raw material in unprocessed form.
- (iv) **Import allowed under WES.**—In addition to imports at the official exchange rate, the public sector importers will be eligible to import any permissible item under Wages Earners' Scheme (WES).
- (v) **Import registration not to apply.**—The condition for registration as importer shall not be applicable to public sector importers.
- (vi) **Restriction on import of aluminium articles.**—Aluminium doors and windows and aluminium sections for making these items shall not be allowed for import by any public sector agency against project import or any other import authorisation, directly or indirectly, through their agents.
- (vii) **Import under sub-allocation of fund.**—Public sector corporations while making sub-allocations to industrial units under their control shall observe the basis of licensing applicable to the private sector industries as mentioned in this order.
- (viii) **Import on Cash Against Delivery (CAD) basis.**—Public sector agencies may opt to import on Cash Against Delivery (CAD) basis in accordance with the procedure laid down by the Bangladesh Bank.

(ix) Guidelines for import of goods by Public Sector Agencies.—

- (a) Competitive quotations shall be obtained before opening of letters of credit and procurement shall be made at the most competitive rate.
- (b) In case of import under cash and untied loan or grant, at least three quotations shall be obtained from registered indentors or from foreign suppliers as per provisions of this Order. This condition shall not apply in case of proprietary items or where value of the consignment is less than Taka 30,000 (Taka thirty thousand) only.

- (x) **Pre-shipment Inspection of Goods.**—Where the value of a single item authorised for import is Tk. 5,00,000 (Taka five lakh) only or above, the importing agency shall arrange pre-shipment inspection. Pre-shipment inspection shall be entrusted to internationally reputed surveyors only. Public Sector Agencies may, however, be allowed to clear goods on production of a certificate from their administrative Ministry to the effect that pre-shipment inspection requirement has been waived by that Ministry in respect of the imported items or that no pre-shipment inspection in respect of a particular consignment was considered necessary.

(xi) Import by the Trading Corporation of Bangladesh (TCB).—

- (a) Trading Corporation of Bangladesh (TCB) shall import goods on the basis of allocation of funds given to them by the Government at the official exchange rate. TCB may also undertake import of any permissible item under WES. In respect of the import of the following items at the official exchange rate, TCB shall share with private sector importers in the proportion mentioned against each items :

	TCB	Private Sector
Soda Ash (Light)	30	70
Milk Food	50	50
Cement (Grey only)	75	25

- (b) The TCB may also undertake import of such items as copper, zinc, aluminium and lead ingot or rod, pig iron (foundry grade), M.S. billets and rape seeds at the official exchange rate on behalf of the public and private sector importers and industrial consumers having entitlement for these items, subject to the following conditions—

- (1) the concerned industrial units shall first submit L/C Authorisation Form as usual to their respective banks for their due share as per basis of licensing notified by the Chief Controller for the private sector importers and as per allocation or sub-allocation of funds made by the Government for the public sector importers :

- (2) if the public and private sector importers and industrial consumers do not want to make importation themselves and instead want to utilize the services of the TCB, they may place order in writing with the TCB enclosing a Bank Guarantee for such amount as may be decided by the TCB for lifting their quota in time after importation;
- (3) the concerned industrial units shall also authorise the TCB to make importation on their behalf by making appropriate endorsement on the reverse of the L/C Authorisation Form duly attested by the Manager of the importers' bank. In such cases, the L/C Authorisation Form may be transferred to any other bank as a special case or on request by the TCB to enable them to make bulk import.
- (c) Arms and ammunitions shall be importable exclusively by the TCB. In addition, TCB may be allowed to import explosives, vegetable ghee, 2mm and 3mm glass sheets and special raw materials for selected export oriented units. The quantity of these items to be imported will be determined by the Ministry of Commerce. Sale of explosives by TCB shall be made under intimation to the Ministry of Home Affairs.
- (d) TCB may import such other items as may be decided by the Government from time to time.
22. **Prescribed conditions for Import of Commercial Items :**
- (i) **Import of Books (ITC No. 49.01, 49.02, 49.03 and 49.05).—**
- (a) Import of Books during 1985-86 financial year shall be allowed only at the official exchange rate. Import of Books and Journals shall not be permissible under Wages Earners' Scheme ;
- (b) Following types of importers shall be eligible to import books at the official exchange rate at a uniform rate of Taka 1.00 (one) lac only:—
- Registered commercial importers of books;
 - Importers registered under WES who imported books at any time during the last three financial years ;
 - Registered commercial importers having valid IRC but no live item, may opt to import books during 1985-86 financial year. But those importers who will have authorisation for import of any other items including those who will opt for any of the items at Sl. Nos. 2-27 in Part 'B' of Restricted List, shall not be eligible to import books; and
 - Subject to provision of paragraph 18(ii), importers of live item under barter may also be allowed to import books and journals but only on proof of first establishment of L/C by them for the respective barter shares for their own item(s).
- (c) Recognised Schools and Colleges may import Books at the official exchange rate up to a ceiling of Taka 20,000.00 (Taka twenty thousand) each for exclusive use in their respective libraries subject to production of a certificate from the Ministry of Education to the effect that the applicant is a recognised school or college, as the case may be ;

- (d) Registered Chamber of Commerce and Industry and other professional persons and bodies may import books and journals at the official exchange rate up to Taka 20,000.00 (Taka twenty thousand) only per importer;
- (e) Universities may import books and journals at the official exchange rate against specific allocations of fund made direct to them by the Government,
- (f) Importers will be free to import the following categories of books.—
- Books—College/University/Madrasha/Toll Text and standard reference books including books on linguistics and literature, research publications, technical and scientific books, law and medical books, dictionary and encyclopaedia;
 - Maps, charts and geographical globes;
 - Journals on scientific, technical, economic, medical and legal subjects;
 - News papers, weeklies and other periodicals as mentioned in the Restricted List; and
- (g) Books other than categories mentioned at sub-paragraph (f) above (e.g. fiction, etc.) may be imported within the above-mentioned ceiling of Tk. 1.00 (Taka one) lac per importer with the prior permission of the Chief Controller.
- (h) While issuing L/C Authorisation Forms for Books and Journals at official exchange rate to the registered commercial importers with no live item and the registered commercial importers with live item under barter, a rubber stamp should be put in the Pass Book of the concerned importer under seal and signature of the Manager of the nominated bank which should read as under :—
“Allowed to import books/journals at official exchange rate during 1985-86 financial year for Tk. _____ as per option exercised by the importer”.

- (ii) **Milk Food.**—Import of milk food shall be subject to the following conditions :—
- (a) Composition and percentage of various ingredients shall have to be printed in Bangla on the container of milk powder;
- (b) The date of manufacture and of expiry of the fitness of the contents for human consumption shall be printed on the container either in Bangla or in English.
- (c) Measuring spoon shall be supplied in all the containers of baby-food i.e. Milk food having fat contents up to 19%.

- (iii) **Non-fat dried milk.**—Import of non-fat dried milk shall be made subject to the following conditions :—
- (a) the importer shall produce analysis certificate authenticated by competent authorities of the exporting country. The certificate will contain a declaration that the milk food is fit for human consumption ;
 - (b) packing shall be in airtight bag/container on which date of manufacture and date of expiry for human consumption shall be marked :
- (iv) **Palm oil.**—
- (a) Import of refined palm oil shall be subject to production of certificates from the health authority and the Chamber of Commerce of the exporting country to the effect that the consignment of the palm oil is fit for human consumption. These certificates shall be submitted to the Customs Authority at the time of clearance of consignments.
 - (b) Solid and semi-solid palm oil, passed as vegetable ghee ; refined, bleached and deodorised (RBD) stearine and crude palm oil/ crude palm stearine shall not be permissible for import, as palm oil.
- (v) **Weights and measures.**—Import of only such weighing machine, weights and measures will be allowed as are based on metric system and supported by prior permission of/registration with Bangladesh Standards Institution.
- (vi) **Common Salt.**—Import of common salt will be allowed only in washed and crushed/ground/powdered/crystal form which is fit for human consumption and free from any harmful ingredient.
- (vii) **Cinematograph Film.**—(a) Cinematograph film (exposed) in English language without sub-title and in other languages (except sub-continental language) with sub-title in Bangla or in English shall be permissible for import.
- (b) Import of film in sub-continental language with or without sub-title shall not be permissible.
 - (c) Import of all Cinematograph film will be subject to censorship rule/code.
- (viii) **Motor vehicles.**—
- (a) Petrol and diesel engine motor car up to 1600 cc only (new, used or reconditioned) with or without dual fuel engine will be importable ;
 - (b) Truck, Bus and other four wheel drive vehicles (Jeep) will be importable in new and completely built-up condition only ;
 - (c) New, used and reconditioned Motor van, pick-up, micro-bus, mini-bus and ambulance will be importable in completely built-up condition only.
 - (d) Passenger transport vehicles having seating capacity up to 14 persons excluding driver shall be classified as Micro-bus ; those having seating capacity from 15 to 32 persons excluding driver shall be classified as Mini-bus and those having seating capacity exceeding 32 persons shall be classified as bus.

- (e) Manufacturing age of the used/reconditioned vehicles must not be more than 5 (five) years at the time of shipment. The five years' time will be calculated from the 1st day of the year next following the year of manufacture of the vehicle.
- (f) The supplier of second-hand vehicle shall furnish written guarantee for making the necessary spares available for a minimum period (three) years from the date of shipment.
- (ix) **Explosives.**—Import of explosives including calcium carbide shall not be allowed except with the prior approval of the Chief Inspector of Explosives of the Ministry of Industries. Commercial import of explosive substances shall not be allowed except through Trading Corporation of Bangladesh (TCB). TCB will sell explosive substances imported by it to actual users under intimation to the Ministry of Home Affairs. Explosive substances shall, however, be importable by the recognised industrial units up to the entitlement for such items as recorded in the Pass Book, with prior approval of the Chief Inspector of Explosives. Explosive substances imported by the industrial units against their entitlements must be utilised in their factory exclusively for production purposes and shall not be sold, transferred or disposed of in any other manner.
- (x) **Plants and Plant Products.**—All importers of plants and plant products shall observe the relevant provisions of the Plant Quarantine Ordinance. Accordingly, all consignments of imported plants and plant products shall be surrendered at the port of entry to the Plant Quarantine Authority for Quarantine action.
- (xi) **Pesticides.**—Import of pesticides shall be made on recommendation of the Agriculture and Forest Division and subject to the following conditions :—
- (a) Containers shall be in good condition and capable of withstanding the risk of handling and carrying by sea;
 - (b) Correct technical name of the contents must be marked on the container;
 - (c) The following information shall be printed clearly in Bangla on the container:
 - Name of product;
 - Name and address of manufacturer or formulator or the person in whose name the pesticides is registered;
 - Net contents;
 - Date of manufacture;
 - Date of test;
 - Normal storage stability;
 - Name and percentage by weight of active ingredients and total percentage of other ingredients;
 - Warning or caution statements such as "out of reach of children", "Danger", "Warning" or "Caution";
 - Antidote, including direction to call a physician; and
 - Direction for use, which are adequate to protect the public.

(xii) Computer.—

(a) For import of Mini or main frame computer, the public sector importers shall be required to obtain No Objection Certificate from the National Computer Committee (NCC). Both private and public sector importers shall inform the National Computer Committee after installation of the computer in their premises, unless otherwise specified.

(b) Foreign Commercial firms dealing in computers may import computer spares and accessories thereof subject to the following conditions—

- Items to be imported should be their own proprietary items;
- Value of the L/C for this purpose shall not exceed Tk. 10.00 lac (Taka ten lacs) only;

The firm shall have valid Import Registration Certificate; and

- The firm shall also be registered with the Income-Tax Authority in Bangladesh.

(c) Such foreign commercial firms dealing in computer may also be allowed to import spares and components for computer on Direct Payment Abroad basis to meet requirement for emergency break-down of computers supplied by them, subject to the condition that sufficient proof of emergency break-down shall have to be produced from the end user to the licensing authority while applying for import permit.

(xiii) C. I. Sheet.—

(a) C. I. sheet up to 26 BWG containing zinc coating of 1.25 oz. per square feet only will be importable. Import during 1985-86 financial year shall be allowed only under WES at a uniform rate of Taka 1.00 lac (Taka one lac) only per importer to the following category of importers :—

- The registered commercial importers of C. I. Sheet or Iron and Steel (Part-I) shall be eligible to submit LCA Form and open L/C for import of C. I. Sheet without any prior permission from any authority;
- Subject to conditions mentioned at sub-paragraph (c) and (d) below, the importers registered under W.E.S. up to 30-6-85 may be allowed to import C.I. Sheet during 1985-86 financial year, on the basis of district-wise allocation of quota to be made on population basis. Selection of importers of C.I. Sheet under district-wise allocation of quota shall be done by a District Committee headed by the Deputy Commissioner of the district concerned. Other members of the Committee will be a representative of the local Chamber of Commerce and Industry and local area Import Control Officer/ representative of the Chief Controller. Where there is no recognised Chamber of Commerce and Industry, a representative of the recognised Town Association and in case where there is no recognised Town Association, a representative of the Chamber of Commerce of the old district may be taken into the Committee. The procedure for selection of importers within the specific district quota will be devised by the respective committees taking into consideration the local condition either on the basis of merit or lottery.

- (b) Applications for opening L/C for import of C.I. Sheet shall not be processed by the banks before a public notice is issued by the Chief Controller in this behalf;
- (c) Following types of importers shall not be eligible to import C.I. Sheet during 1985-86 financial year :—
- registered commercial importers and importers under WES who are allowed to import second-hand clothing during 1985-86 financial year.
 - Importers under WES who opt for import of books during 1985-86 financial year.
 - registered commercial importers who are authorised to import any other commercial item under cash or commodity aid or any of the 26 items under WES which are mentioned at serial No.2 to 27 at Part-B of Restricted List;
- (d) Subject to the provision of paragraph 18 (ii), registered commercial importers who have live items only under barter sources during 1985-86 financial year may apply for participation in the selection of importers for C.I. Sheet within the district quota.
- (xiv) **Second-hand Clothing :—**
- (a) Import of Second-hand Clothing falling under ITC heading No. 63-01 during 1985-86 financial year shall be allowed, under WES only at a uniform rate of Taka 1-00 (Taka one) lac only per importer, to the following categories :—
- registered commercial importers of second hand clothing shall be eligible to submit LCA Forms and open L/C for import of second-hand clothing without any prior permission from any authority; and
 - Subject to conditions mentioned at sub-paragraphs (c) and (d) below the registered commercial importers of other items and the importers registered under WES up to 30-6-85, may be allowed to import second hand clothing during 1985-86 financial year as per the district-wise quota allocated on population basis. The procedures for selection of importers and composition of the District Committee shall be the same as in the case of C.I. Sheets;
- (b) Applications for opening L/C for import of second hand clothing shall not be processed by the banks before a public notice is issued by the Chief Controller in this behalf;
- (c) Following types of importers shall not be eligible to import second-hand clothing during 1985-86 financial year :—
- importers who are allowed to import C.I. Sheet during 1985-86 financial year;
 - Importers under WES who opt for import of books during 1985-86 financial year.
 - registered commercial importers who are allowed to import any commercial item under cash or commodity aid or any of the items included at serial 2 to 27 in Part-B of Restricted List, under WES;

- (d) Subject to provision of paragraph 18 (ii), registered commercial importers who have live item only under barter sources during 1985-86 financial year may participate in the selection of importers for second-hand clothing out of district quota ;
- (e) The following items shall not be permissible for import as secondhand clothing under the relevant ITC number 63.01.—
- (i) Secondhand clothing made of 100% cotton ;
 - (ii) Rags ;
 - (iii) Secondhand mosquito net ;
 - (iv) Secondhand drapes (screen), all sorts ;
 - (v) Secondhand vests (ganjees), all sorts ;
 - (vi) Secondhand underwear (ladies or gents) ;
 - (vii) Secondhand brassiers ; and
 - (viii) Secondhand bed sheet and bed linen.
- (f) All consignments of secondhand clothing shall be accompanied by a certificate from a recognised Chamber of Commerce of the exporting country certifying that the consignment does not contain any item whose import is banned under the relevant ITC.
- (xv) Textile fabrics.—Textile fabrics (cotton and synthetic) of standard packing in regular and continuous length of 20 (twenty) yds. or above in a *thaan* only shall be permissible, subject to conditions specified in the Restricted List.

23. Prescribed conditions for import of industrial items :

- (i) Items of import for Foreign Exchange Earning Hotels:—Foreign Exchange Earning Hotels may import items, included in the Restricted List as importable by them subject to the following conditions and procedure:—
- (a) Import of the items in the restricted list will be limited to 20% of the foreign exchange earned by the hotel during a specified period ;
 - (b) Import of alcoholic beverages and spares shall be limited to a maximum of 7½% (seven and a half percent) of the total foreign exchange earning and remaining 12½% (twelve and a half percent) may be utilised for import of other item(s) in the Restricted List. Total import of restricted items shall not exceed 20% (twenty percent) of the total earnings of foreign exchange referred to at (a) above ;
 - (c) Out of 12½% (twelve and a half percent) entitlement for other items the foreign exchange earning hotel will be allowed to import crockery, cutlery and hollow glassware, once in five years, subject to prior permission from the Chief Controller, on the basis of specific recommendation from the Director General of Industries. Crockery, cutlery and hollow glassware imported by such hotel shall bear the insignia of the hotel engraved or painted with indelible paint ;

- (d) Foreign Exchange Earnings shall be recorded in the Pass Book by the bank to whom the foreign exchange is sold. Utilization of foreign exchange will be recorded in the Pass Book by the nominated bank while opening L/C for these restricted items; and
- (e) Before submitting LCA Form and opening of L/C for any restricted item(s), the foreign exchange earning hotel shall obtain endorsement in the Pass Book from the concerned Licensing Authority.
- (ii) **Import of Coal and Hard Coke.—**
- (a) Brick manufacturers and recognised industrial units requiring steam coal and hard coke may be allowed to import coal and hard coke respectively at the official exchange rate at a uniform rate of Tk. 5,00,000-(Taka five lac) only per importer under cash provided they furnish certificate from registered chamber of commerce/trade bodies regarding their genuineness;
- (b) If the brick manufacturers and recognised industrial units requiring steam coal/hard coke fail to establish L/C within the specified period or if the total value of L/Cs established by them falls short of the available allocation for these items, balance quantity may be offered to the registered commercial importers and importers under Wages Earners' Scheme on first-come first-served basis;
- (c) Government departments and statutory corporations shall import their own requirements of coal and hard coke against their specific allocation of foreign exchange;
- (d) Commercial import of coal and hard coke shall be permissible under Wages Earners' Scheme (WES).
- (iii) **Palm Kernal Oil.—**Import of Palm Kernal Oil shall be allowed only to the recognised units under soap industry having entitlement for the item as per Pass Book.
- (iv) **Coconut Oil.—**Coconut Oil shall be importable by the recognised industrial units having entitlement for the item as raw material. Recognised units under soap industry having entitlement for this item may, however, be allowed to import coconut oil with free fatty acid content not less than 1 (one per cent) within their due share.
- (v) **M. S. Billets.—**Recognised industrial units having entitlement for M.S. Billets shall be allowed to import only prime quality M. S. Billets up to 100% of their annual import entitlement for this item irrespective of the source of finance. Import of M.S. Billets shall be subject to the pre-shipment inspection through internationally reputed surveyor. Necessary certificate regarding pre-shipment inspection shall be produced to the Customs Authority at the time of clearance of goods.
- (vi) **M.S. Sheet and Plate (hot rolled), G.P. Sheet, B.P. Sheet, Stainless Steel Sheet, CRCA Sheet, Tin Plate, M.S. Sheet.—**
- (a) Secondary quality (odd pieces but new) of G.P. sheet (not exceeding 4" feet in length), B.P. Sheet, M.S. Sheet, Stainless Steel Sheet and CRCA Sheet shall be importable only by the recognised industrial units up to 100% (one hundred percent) of their annual entitlement for the item (s). Commercial import of secondary quality of these items shall not be allowed. However, Tin Plate secondary quality or misprint will be importable.

- (b) M.S. Sheet and plate (hot rolled) will be importable only by recognised industrial units up to their annual entitlement for the item as recorded in the Pass Book. This restriction will not apply to recognised agricultural implements manufacturing industry.
- (c) Commercial import of G.P. Sheet shall not be permissible.
- (d) Import of G.P. Sheet by recognised industrial units shall be allowed as per Annex. VI.
- (vii) **Carpet Wool.**—Import of carpet wool may be allowed by the Chief Controller only to the woollen carpet making industrial units provided they submit recommendation from the Sponsoring Authority and certificate from the Export Promotion Bureau showing yearwise value of the carpet exported by them during the last 3 (three) years. However, import of knitting wool shall not be permissible.
- (viii) **Secondhand/reconditioned machinery.**—Import of secondhand or reconditioned machinery including secondhand or reconditioned capital machinery up to Taka 25,00,000 (Taka twenty-five lac) only may be allowed under WES without any recommendation from the Sponsoring Authority or prior permission from licensing authority. For import of such machinery for any value exceeding Taka 1,00,000 (Taka one lac) only but not exceeding Taka 25,00,000 (Taka twenty-five lac) only a certificate from an internationally reputed surveyor to the effect that the machinery has an economic and useful life of at least ten years shall have to be produced to the nominated bank before opening letter of credit. If the value exceeds Taka 25,00,000 (Taka twenty-five lac) only, prior recommendation from the sponsoring authority shall be necessary in addition to the Surveyors certificate mentioned above.
- (ix) **Aluminium container.**—Empty lacquered drum shall not be importable. However, aluminium tin container (printed) will be allowed for import by the recognised industrial units in cosmetics sector which manufacture cream under approved licensing agreement.
- (x) **RBD Palm Stearine.**—
- (a) Recognised industrial units under soap industry may be allowed to import the item up to the entitlement of the item recorded in the Pass Book only on the basis of specific recommendation of the sponsoring authority.
- (b) Commercial import of RBD Stearine shall not be permissible under any source of finance.
- (xi) **Machinery and spare parts for Jute and Cotton Textile Mills.**—Import of machinery and spare parts for jute and cotton textile mills shall not be allowed except with the prior permission from the Ministry of Jute and Textiles.

(xii) Lactose, sucrose, icing sugar and liquid glucose.:

(a) Lactose shall be importable by the recognised units under the industrial sector "Homoeopathic Medicines" up to 30% (thirty per cent) of their total annual entitlement as recorded in the Pass Book irrespective of source of finance. Eligible commercial importers of homoeopathic and biochemic medicines may also import the item up to 30% (thirty per cent) of declared share. Except for these two categories of importers, no other importer shall be allowed to import lactose under any source of finance.

(b) Lactose BP and USP, Sucrose BP and USP and Icing Sugar shall be importable only by the recognised pharmaceutical units in proportion to the production programme of each pharmaceutical unit. Director of Drugs Administration while approving the block list of raw materials for each pharmaceutical unit will specify the total quantity each of Lactose BP and USP, Sucrose BP and USP and icing sugar which the pharmaceutical unit may import during 1985-86 financial year.

(c) Only the recognised industrial units having entitlement for liquid glucose will be allowed to import this item up to 50% of their entitlement for the item as recorded in the Pass Book, irrespective of the source of finance.

(xiii) Dextrose monohydrate.—Only the recognised industrial units having entitlement for dextrose monohydrate will be allowed to import this item on specific recommendation of the sponsoring authority.

(xiv) Wood for manufacture of bobbins, shuttle and pencils (ITC No. 44.05).—

(a) The following types of wood shall be permissible for Bobbin manufacturing industry:

- (xv) Umbrella Cloth.—Cotton umbrella cloth "dyed fast black not more than 22" (twenty-two inches) in width edge border $\frac{1}{2}''$ to $1\frac{1}{2}''$ on one side or on both sides" shall only be permissible for import. For import of umbrella cloth of any other description or specification, recognised industrial units shall obtain prior permission from the Chief Controller on the basis of recommendation from the sponsoring authority.

(xvi) **Items of import by ad hoc I. W. T. Operators, Poultry and Dairy Farms and Fish Catching Units.**—Banks may accept L/C Authorisation Form from Inland Water Transport operators, poultry and dairy farms and fish catching units on *ad hoc* basis only on specific instruction from the Chief Controller. The Chief Controller shall permit Inland Water Transport operators to import permissible items on the recommendation of the Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority (BIWTA). Similarly, permission may be accorded to the fish catching units for import of permissible raw materials on *ad hoc* basis on recommendation of the Director of Fisheries and to the poultry and dairy farms for import of breeds of livestock and poultry and veterinary medicines on an *ad hoc* basis on the recommendation of the Director of Livestock Services. Import of machinery and equipment for fish catching, poultry and dairy farms on an *ad hoc* basis will, however, be issued on the basis of recommendation from the Director General of Industries. Inland Water Transport operators, fish catching units and poultry and dairy farms having valid Import Registration Certificate under WES may import permissible items under WES as per their requirement without any recommendation from either the Bangladesh Water Transport Authority or the Directorate of Fisheries or Directorate of Livestock as the case may be. They shall, however, follow other formalities and procedures of imports as per this Order.

(xvii) **Items of import by Export-oriented Industries in the Textile Sector.**—

(a) Recognised units under readymade garments industry operating under the bonded warehouse system shall be permitted to import their permissible raw and packing materials on the basis of confirmed irrevocable letter of credit for export of readymade garments against back-to-back letter of credit, subject to authorisation by the Bangladesh Bank. Such units shall not, however, be allowed to import fabrics cut into pieces or sizes and will have to import only Thaan fabrics. For this purpose, no prior permission from the Chief Controller shall be required. For import of knitted fabrics by the export-oriented readymade garment units, each unit will obtain recommendation from the Department of Textiles for each shipping period. Such units under readymade garments industry shall, however, be permitted to import raw materials 'on no cost basis' for execution of export orders, on the following conditions—

- (1) Each case will be considered on consignment basis and this shall not involve any remittance from Bangladesh;
- (2) Pre-shipment inspection certificate on finished products if insisted on, at buyer's cost will have to be produced during execution of export and no rejection will be allowed ;
- (3) Value added shall not be less than 25% and the entire value added, not being less than 25%, will have to be repatriated to Bangladesh ;
- (4) Quantity, price and description of the materials imported on consignment basis must be mentioned in the invoice.

- (b) Recognised units under specialised textile industry operating under the bonded warehouse system shall be permitted to import their permissible raw and packing materials on the basis of confirmed and irrevocable letter of credit for export of the items of specialised textiles against back-to-back letter of credit, subject to authorisation by the Bangladesh Bank. For this purpose no prior permission from the Chief Controller shall be required. Specialised Textile units operating under the bonded warehouse system may, however, meet their import requirement for cotton yarn (single) of below 21 counts and above 59 counts only under WES on the basis of confirmed and irrevocable export order. The imported cotton yarn will invariably be kept in the bonded warehouse and shall be used for production of exportable goods only. Recognised units under specialised textile industry who are not operating under the bonded warehouse system shall import their requirement against L/C Authorisation Forms as per the basis of licensing applicable to the sector.
- (c) Recognised export-oriented hosiery units operating under bonded warehouse system shall be permitted to import their permissible raw and packing materials on the basis of confirmed and irrevocable letter of credit for export of hosiery and knitted wear goods against back-to-back letter of credit, subject to authorisation by the Bangladesh Bank. For this purpose, no prior permission from the Chief Controller shall be required. However, such units shall not be allowed to import hosiery knitted or woven fabrics, all sorts, in rolls or thana or cut into sizes or pieces.
- (d) Import of knitted fabrics all sorts in rolls or thanas including knitted pieces and rolls of sweater, jumper, pullover and muffler shall not be permissible for hosiery and other knitted goods sector, but import of knitted fabrics in rolls or thanas only shall be permissible for recognised export-oriented readymade garments industry working under bonded warehouse system.
- (e) Export-oriented Readymade Garments/Hosiery/Specialised Textile industries operating under bonded warehouse system may be allowed to import against back-to-back L/C their respective items which are placed in Restricted List for import by the above industries only. A List of such restricted items is placed in the Annex-VII for convenience of the concerned importers. Such items imported by the concerned export-oriented units shall be utilised in their own factory for production of goods for export purposes only and the same shall not be sold or disposed of within the country or used to produce goods for local sale/consumption. Any violation of this condition shall amount to contravention of ITC Regulations.

ANNEX-V

PROCEDURE FOR IMPORT ON JOINT BASIS

Group by Commercial Importers—Commercial importers have been allowed the facility of import on joint basis for the sake of economy after forming group either before or after registration of the L/C Authorization Form with the registration unit of Bangladesh Bank as per provision of Import Policy Order, 1985-86. Such importers, having different nominated banks, desirous of importing of their share in cash, loan or credit and barter on joint basis may do so in accordance with the procedure mentioned below :

2. Procedure in case of formation of group for import on joint basis, before registration of L/C Authorization Form by the registration unit of Bangladesh Bank :

- (i) An importer will submit to his nominated bank the L/C Authorization Form in the usual Manner duly filled in and signed along with a Declaration that (a) he had not applied in any manner to import his share for the current shipping period individually and agrees to effect import of the same on joint basis under the Group leadership of M/S (Name and address of the group leader with IRC No. and his nominated bank to be mentioned), and that (b) he undertakes not to make in any manner any claim whatsoever from the licensing authority in any matter arising out of default or dispute with the group leader or members of the group. Signature of the importer will be verified by the authorized officer of the nominated bank with date.
- (ii) The importer's nominated bank after being satisfied that the L/C Authorization Form, the declaration given by the importer and other required information are complete and correct in all respects, will forward these papers to the nominated bank of the group leader and will certify on the body of L/C Authorization Form as under:

"We have no objection to allow the abovementioned group under the group leadership of M/S.....

 This importer is eligible to import.....
 for Taka..... We have endorsed their
 Pass Book.

*Seal and signature of the Authorized Officer
 of the importer's bank with date".*

- (iii) The group leader will submit L/C Authorization Form in a similar manner. In addition to L/C Authorization Form he will also submit L/C Application Form covering the total value of all the L/C Authorization Form of the group members including his own share. He will also submit a declaration to the effect that (a) particulars given in the L/C Authorization Form are correct to the best of his knowledge, that (b) he has not applied, in any manner, to import his share for the current shipping period separately other than as

a member of the group and that (c) he has undertaken to act as the group leader for importation on joint basis for the sake of economy by the importers in the group (here group leader will record the names and address and IRC Nos. of all the members including that of himself and their individual shares) and that (d) he undertakes not to make in any manner any claim whatsoever from the licensing authority or authorities in any matter arising out of default or dispute with members in the group. The signature of the group leader will be verified by the authorized officer of his bank with date.

- (iv) The group leader's bank, after being satisfied that L/C Authorization Form and the declaration given by the group leader are complete and correct in all respects, will certify on the body of the L/C Authorization Form as under: "We have no objection to allow the above importer to act as group leader of the group.....members."

*Seal and signature of the Authorized Officer
of the group leader's bank with date.*

- (v) The group leader's bank will then forward L/C Authorization Form, declaration of the group leader and their certificate along with the complete set of L/C Authorization Forms, declarations of all members of the group and the complete set of certificates issued by the different banks of the members, to the registration unit of the Bangladesh Bank in the respective offices of the licensing authority. If group members belong to different licensing jurisdictions, the group leader's bank will submit L/C Authorization Form of the group leader and its associate members to the respective registration unit of Bangladesh Bank where the group leader is located.
- (vi) Bangladesh Bank registration unit immediately after the registration of the L/C Authorization Form will forward to the concerned licensing authority of the importer two copies of the complete set of L/C Authorization Forms alongwith declarations and certificate for post check and simultaneously return the other two copies of LCAs to the nominated bank of the group leader for opening of L/C.
- (vii) Where the eligible commercial importers, desirous of importing their shares in cash, IDA Credit or untied loan or credit belong to the same nominated bank including all the branches of the same banks, the procedure for import on joint basis will be the same as outlined above except that different branches of the same bank will forward the complete sets of documents outlined above such as L/C Authorization Form, declaration, etc. after recording the required certificate on the body of L/C Authorization Forms to the branch of the same bank which is the nominated bank of the group leader. The nominated bank of the group leader will process the L/C Authorization Forms in the same manner as outlined above.
- (viii) In the case of barter, STA and tied loan or Credit, eligible commercial importers desirous of importing on joint basis, will submit the L/C Authorization Forms to their nominated banks in the prescribed manner but need not submit application for opening of letter of credit. The nominated bank, on being satisfied that the L/C

Authorization Form is in order, will forward all the copies of the same to the nominated bank of the group leader after making necessary entries in the importer's Pass Book or on the Import Registration Certificate in the absence of Pass Book. On being satisfied that the L/C Authorization Form of the group leader and that of group members are in order and after the completion of all formalities of import on joint basis, nominated bank of the group leader will transmit complete set of the L/C Authorization Forms of each member of the group including that of the group leader, to the designated bank along with the application form for opening of Letter of Credit to be submitted by the group leader for the total amount covered by individual L/C Authorization Forms. The designated bank will open Letter of Credit and endorse two copies each of the L/C Authorization Form to the concerned licensing office.

3. Procedure in case of formation of group for import on joint basis after registration of L/C Authorization Form :

- (i) In case of formation of group for import on joint basis after registration of L/C Authorization Form, an importer will submit to his nominated bank the L/C Authorization Form in usual manner along with an intimation to his bank in writing or a declaration that he desires to form group after the registration of LCA Form. The importer's nominated bank after being satisfied that the L/C Authorization Forms are complete and correct in all respects, will forward it to the concerned registration unit of the Bangladesh Bank along with the declaration. On receipt back of the L/C Authorization Form duly registered from the registration unit of Bangladesh Bank, the nominated bank of the importer shall at once inform the importer to form a group or groups immediately.
- (ii) The importer while forming a group, shall be required to submit a declaration to their bank exactly in the same terms as laid down under para. 2(i) of this Annex. Signature of the importer will also be verified by the authorized officer of the nominated bank with date. The said bank will forward all these papers, *i.e.*, L/C Authorization Form and declaration to the nominated bank of the group leader with certificate as laid down in para 2(ii) of this Annex.
- (iii) The group leader shall also submit L/C Authorization Form and L/C Application Form with a declaration as mentioned in para 2(iii) of this Annex. The signature of the group leader will be verified by the authorized officer of his bank with date and will endorse required certificate on the body of L/C Authorization Form mentioned in para 2(iv).
- (iv) The group leader's bank will then keep two complete sets of L/C Authorization Forms, declarations of all group members and certificates issued by the different banks of the group members with complete set of L/C Authorization Form including declaration and certificate issued in respect of group leader for opening of L/C and forward other 2 (two) copies of L/C Authorization Forms along with complete set of papers (declarations and certificates) to the concerned licensing authority for post checking. If group members belong to different licensing jurisdictions complete set of papers shall be submitted to the concerned licensing offices of the group members for post checking.

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- (v) Where the eligible commercial importers, desirous of importing their share on joint basis, are located within the jurisdiction of the same licensing authority and have the same nominated bank including all the branches of the banks within the jurisdiction of the same licensing office, the procedure for import on joint basis will be the same as outlined above except that the different branches of the same will forward the complete set of documents outlined above to the branch or the same bank which is the nominated bank of the group leader. The nominated bank of the group leader will process the L/C Authorization Forms in the same manner as outlined above.
- (vi) In case of import on joint basis under barter, STA and tied loan or credit, the procedure as mentioned above in para 2(viii) shall be followed.

4. In both cases of the formation of group, as soon as L/C is opened and transmitted to the foreign supplier, the nominated bank of the group leader will endorse the Pass Book of the group leader or IRC as the case may be and advise the concerned licensing authority or authorities and the respective banks of the members of the group about the particulars of the L/C with individual share of each member of the group.

5. **Group by industrial importers.**—In case of import by industrial units on joint basis, they should nominate a group leader and request their nominated bank to forward their LCAs along with other relevant papers and Pass Book to the nominated bank of the group leader for opening of L/C in accordance with the procedure outlined under paras 2 and 3 of this Annex. The group leader's nominated bank after verification of the Pass Books and LCA Forms shall open Letter of Credit on joint basis and endorse the LCA Forms and Pass books accordingly.

6. Importers submitting L/C Authorization Form for opening of L/C or effecting import on joint basis in violation of the provisions of the Import Policy Order, 1985-86 or of this Annex shall be liable to action as per provision of this Order.
