No. S.R.O. 361-L/75.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the subsection (5) of section 15D of the Income-tax Act, 1922 (Act XI of 1922), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to approve the Chittagong Lions Foundation for purposes of that section subject to the following conditions:

- that the accounts of the Foundation shall be fully audited by a Chartered Accountant every year;
- (2) that such audited accounts shall be submitted to the Deputy Commissioner of Taxes in whose territorial jurisdiction the head office of the Foundation is situated:
- (3) that in the event of dissolution of the Foundation its assets left after meeting its liabilities, if any, shall be transferred to another institution or fund approved under section 15D (5) of the Income-tax Act; and
- (4) that the Foundation shall not make any donation or grant to any other charitable institution or fund unless it is an institution or fund approved under section 15D(5) of the Income-tax Act.
