NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 29th October, 1976.

No. S.R.O. 368-L/76.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the sub-section (1) of section 15D of the Income-tax Act, 1922 (Act XI of 1922), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to approve Daruss-alam Orphanage, Dacca, for purposes of that section subject to the following conditions:—

- (1) A copy of the accounts audited by Chartered Accountants every year shall be submitted to Deputy Commissioner of Taxes in whose territorial jurisdiction it is situated;
- (2) The Orphanage shall not make any donation or grant to any other charitable institution or fund unless it is an institution or fund approved under section 15D (1);
- (3) That in the event of dissolution of the Orphanage its assets left after meeting its liabilities, if any, shall be transferred to another institution or fund approved under section 15D(1) of the Income-tax Act, 1922.

NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 29th October, 1976.

No. S.R.O. 369-L/76.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 178 of the Navy Ordinance, 1961 (Ordinance XXXV of 1961) the Government is pleased to make the following amendment in the Pay and Allowances Regulations for the Navy (1960), namely :—

In the aforesaid Regulations for rule 114 the following shall be *substituted*, namely :—

“Rule 114. An acting allowance at the rate of Taka 50·00 per month may be granted to Master Chief Petty Officers/Chief Petty Officers when acting in the vacancies of Sub Lieutenants/Lieutenants/Honorary Sub Lieutenants/Honorary Lieutenants in all Circumstances including those caused by Sub Lieutenants/Lieutenants/Honorary Sub Lieutenants/Honorary Lieutenant proceeding on privilege leave except when the persons concerned are required to act—

(a) for a period of 30 days or less;

or

(b) in casual leave or T.D.L.R. Vacancies.

No promotion in place of acting Master Chief Petty Officers and Chief Petty Officers shall be made. This allowance shall be admissible to Master Chief Petty Officers and Chief Petty Officers carrying out the duties of Sub-Lieutenants/Lieutenants/Honorary Sub Lieutenants/Honorary Lieutenants in the ship or establishment where the vacancy actually exists. Whenever it is intended to appoint a Master Chief Petty Officer/Chief Petty Officer to act in place of a Sub Lieutenant/Lieutenant/Honorary Lieutenant, the Master Chief Petty Officer/Chief Petty Officer shall be transferred to the particular ship or establishment where a vacancy exists within the authorised complement. All claims for acting allowances shall be supported by a certificate from the Commanding Officer of the ship or establishment”.
