ORDER

Dacca, the 6th November 1981.

No. S.R.O. 369-L/81.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Stamp Act, 1899 (II of 1899), the Government is pleased to reduce the stamp duty payable by an Income-tax Practitioner and a Chartered Accountant as defined in sub-section (2) of section 61 of the Income-tax Act, 1922 (II of 1922), for filing power of attorney by the amount and under the circumstances stated below:—

Circumstances.	Reduction.
When presented singly for the conduct of any tax case—	
(a) to any Assistant Commissioner or Deputy Commissioner of Taxes or Joint Commissioner of Taxes or Assistant Collector or Deputy Collector of Customs or Joint Collector of Customs;	Tk. 8.00
(b) to a Commissioner of Taxes or Collector of Customs and Excise;	Tk. 7.00
(c) to the Chief Revenue or Executive Authority including the Income-Tax Appellate Tribunal.	Tk. 6.00
