No. S.R.O.-375-L/81.—The following draft of certain further amendments in Income-tax Rules, which the National Board of Revenue proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 59 of the Income-tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922), is published as required by sub-section (1) of that section for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration after the 19th December 1981.

In the aforesaid Rules in rule 7A, for sub-rule (2), the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(2) The firms seeking registration, having capital exceeding Tk. 10 lakh, irrespective of their turnover or receipts, must get their books of accounts audited by Chartered Accountants.”
