Dhaka, the 14th November, 1984

No. S.R.O. 499-L/84/Misc.-3/81 (Poll-IV)/721.—In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 9 of the Manoeuvres, Field Firing and Artillery Practice Act, 1938 (V of 1938), the Government is hereby pleased to give notice of its intention to issue notification under sub-section (2) of the said section authorising the carrying out of field firing and artillery practice throughout the area (Faujdarhat-Halishaha Range in the district of Chittagong) as defined in this Ministry's notification No. S.R.O. 269-L/82/Misc.-3/81 (Poll-IV)/411, dated the 10th July, 1982, and also specified in the Schedule below :—

SCHEDULE

a. **Limit of the Gun Area :** The gun position can be selected anywhere on the sea coast provided that :

(1) It is within 1500 yards from the high tide water level towards the east.

(2) Northern limit : Faujdarhat

(a) Longitude : 91°-45'-20" E

Latitude : 22°-23'-30" N

**b. Demarcation or Limit of the Firing and Danger Zone (that is Target Area):**

- (1) Northern limit :  $330^{\circ}$  from Faujdarhat (location given above).
- (2) Southern limit :  $280^{\circ}$  from Haliashahar (location given above).
- (3) Radius/Distance/Extension of firing Zone from firing point : 12000 yds. or 6.8 miles towards the sea and sky over the sea, subject to the limit in the north and the south.
- (4) Height of Danger Zone : 22,000 feet.

**c. Boundary of the Area :** The area is bounded by a line joining successively the following geographical points :
