No. S.R.O. 514-L/84/MFP/IRD-III/NS/Admn-II/84.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following amendments in the **Gazetted Officers (Department of National Savings, Ministry of Finance) Recruitment Rules, 1979**, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,—

- (a) in rule 1, the comma and the words “, Ministry of Finance” shall be omitted;
- (b) in rule 3, in sub-rule (1), in clause (b) for the full-stop at the end a semi-colon and the word “; or” shall be substituted and thereafter the following new clause (c) shall be added, namely:—

“(c) by transfer on deputation.”; and
